Durell M. Gilbert, 59, of Edgewood, Maryland, died at University of Maryland Medical Center on Tuesday, September 21, 2004. He was born April 20, 1945 in Bad Axe, the son of the late Leonard "Ducky" Gilbert and Vera (Toner) Gilbert. Durell worked as an electronic engineer. He served his country in the Army during the Vietnam Conflict.
