- Student must plan a career in an Agricultural field and have a major that reflects the intent to graduate in an Agricultural capacity.
- Student may use scholarship money at any accredited community/junior college or four-year college/university.
- Application *must* be accompanied by two (2) letters of recommendation.
- All applications must be completely filled out and **PRINTED IN INK.**
- An official transcript for grades 9-12 must be included with the application.
- * Selected applicants will be required to attend a 2023 Summer Session Mid Valley Cowbelles Membership Meeting (date to be determined by the Board) for introduction and recognition. <u>Approximate</u> meeting time will be 6:00pm. Applicants will be notified of the date by the Scholarship Chairman during the prior month.
- * Funds for the selected recipients will be distributed no later than <u>September 15th</u> of the awarding year upon proof of enrollment/admission. Documents must be received by the Scholarship Chairman by this date or the scholarship becomes <u>null and void</u>. Contact information for the Scholarship Chairman is found at the end of this application.
