It is a warm summer afternoon in Beverly Hills, California and I'm sitting on the patio having drinks with Futurist Mark B. Barron. You might know Mark for his inventions S-1 GARD and MDZ Shield which have saved many lives. But today, we are talking about Consumeron™ - Your Personal Assistant On Demand™.

You might have heard that Amazon has a new service called Amazon Prime. Amazon has been working on this system for years. There's no need to go shopping anymore, only they forgot one thing - to talk to the Futurist. They would have known about Mark's August 14, 2012, patented solution, "method for remote acquisition and delivery of goods."

Right now our mobile networks (4G) can actually handle what is needed to make the system work. In talking with Mark, he told me that they will be going to Dubai to do the pilot. I only hope that once the pilot is over that they come right back here in BH so we can be the first to use it.

You may say that there are other companies like this already but none of them have made the connection with streaming video the way Consumeron has done it. With the patent protecting them, they are poised for

The Consumeron will come with the following services once it is up and fully running: personal assistant, remote control shopping, intra-city to international shopping, rapid requests, last mile express, used goods revolution, hotel and motel assistance, proxy pay and GPS tracking.

The Consumeron service that Mark is creating is an actual job creation engine. How? Aside from the technology that will be needed, the "Grabbers" a Mark-ism, is the perfect job for someone who doesn't want to work for minimum wage. It's a quick way to build up a great clientele in the service industry. If done right, it will be like a taxi service of independent contractors working different regions.
