Domestic Violence Treatment: DVOMB Approved for Domestic Violence Treatment for Male, Female, and Same-Sex individuals

Level II Education & Therapy: Licensed by the Office of Behavioral Health to provide DMV required treatment for DUI & DWAI Cases in Colorado

Substance Abuse & Relapse Prevention: Treatment and support to assist those abusing or addicted to alcohol and/or drugs to achieve recovery

Anger Management: A program for those who experience anger issues or who have been convicted of a violent crime other than domestic violence

Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (CBT): A personal development and self-awareness program to help individuals achieve success in life

Seeking Safety: A combination of trauma and substance abuse treatment to assist individuals with creating a healthy and secure lifestyle for themselves

Moral Reconciliation Therapy (MRT): An evidence based practice that is a systematic, cognitive behavioral, step-by-step treatment strategy. Designed to enhance self-image, promote growth of a positive, productive identity, and facilitate the development of higher stages of moral reasoning

Parenting: Parenting classes focus on the effects of domestic violence, substance abuse, and examine the inter-generational patterns and how they relate to children

Specialized Parenting: A parenting treatment designed specifically for those who have severe child abuse charges.

Individual Therapy: A one-on-one with a trained counselor to resolve issues that brought you to therapy and help you in improving your quality of life

Evaluations and Assessments: Aurora Center for Treatment offers evaluations and assessment services for Mental Health and Substance Abuse

Monitored Sobriety: We offer a range of monitored sobriety tests, including urinalysis testing, oral swab testing, and breathalyzer testing. Please contact our agency to check our walk-in hours.
