We are just glad she called our center and soon arrived to meet with a client advocate. As suspected, her pregnancy test was positive. "What am I going to do? When is my due date? Why is this happening?" She established a trusting and compassionate relationship with her advocate; she learned more about preparing for childbirth, and making important decisions about her future, including keeping her baby.

When Kirsten discovered she was pregnant, she was told she had "no other option" but abortion. Frightened and desperate, she took the abortion pill at 5 weeks pregnant and buried her pain. Years later after becoming crippled by regret and anger, Kirsten opened and found help and healing through CPC's post-abortion classes. Fast forward to today – Kirsten is a thriving mother of two living a healthy God-honoring life.

You helped make this vision a reality. This life a survivor. This mom whole again. And for that, we are ever so grateful.
