**Join us for a week full of friends, family, fellowship, and adventure while touring Model T roads through Ohio and Indiana.**

You will see historical sites and shops along the way, such as antique stores, log houses, historic farms, ice cream shops, and other local attractions. We feel very blessed to have a great area that we enjoy with all of our Model T friends and we are excited about sharing that with you!

The host hotel, Spooky Nook, will be brand new and is set to open in January 2022. So no reservations can be made there right now, but soon. The host hotel will include an onsite restaurant, local shops, and activities on site. (There is no pool and breakfast is not included.) Registration, club sales, Youth Auction, and banquet will all be held at Spooky Nook. The second hotel, Courtyard Marriott, is located across the river from Spooky Nook, less than a mile away. The Courtyard offers a hot breakfast and a pool. Reservations are now open and can be made by calling 1-800-MARRIOTT (Model T World Tour 2022). There are multiple options for camping. Please contact us for more information.

Registration will open on Saturday, July 16, with optional tours available for anyone who wants an extra day of driving before the tour begins. The car show and opening lunch will take place on Sunday at Jungle Jim's International Market, where you may ride the monorail over the car show to lunch. Other activities will be available as well.

Every morning will start with a donut stop on The Butler County Donut Trail, in which we will participate all week for a local souvenir.

All week long we will have tours that will lead you through Ohio and Indiana on roads Model T's were made for. We will drive through the shaded Ohio River Valley, where we have roads with rolling hills, but we will also enjoy easy driving on flat and straight roads as well. We will follow parts of an old canal, drive through covered bridges, visit local historic farms and an old German settlement, tour a convent, meet some wolves, and visit some relaxing overlooks along the way. Daily tours will be designed to take your time and enjoy the area and have time to visit with friends along the way. The tour will end with a closing banquet on Friday evening. If anyone wants to stay after the tour, Hamilton is host to a historic car show and parade on Saturday, July 23.

We are planning a lot of youth activities for kids of all ages. Youth 18 and under will be free to attend the tour! The youth will have things to do everyday on the tours and will also have time to visit with friends and make new friends.
