Mrs. Mary Ann "Mae" Tyll, 87, of Ubly passed away Thursday morning, Jan. 17, 2002, at Courtney Manor of Bad Axe. She was born on Sept. 8, 1914, in Detroit to the late Andrew and Frances (Owedyk) Ciupka. She married Edward John Tyll on May 25, 1935, at St. Stanislaus in Detroit.
