## Zoning change for 7100 East US Highway 290

In accordance with Council Resolution No. 20180823-078 and No. 20180920-096, the City of Austin has proposed changing the zoning for the Patton Courts Mobile Home Park located at 7100 East US Highway 290 from general commercial services-neighborhood plan (CS-NP) combining district, general commercial services-mixed use-neighborhood plan (CSMU-NP) combining district, and townhouse and condominium residence (SF-6)

district to mobile home residence-neighborhood plan (MH-NP) combining district. The Coronado Hills Contact Team will be hosting a community meeting open to all interested parties, tentatively scheduled for 6:30 pm on March 13.

#### Project Teams
