

**Paciorkowski, Albert E.
(Pakowski)
Essexville, Michigan**



Albert E. Paciorkowski (Pakowski), age 88 years, died Monday, November 11, 1996 in the Town and Country Nursing Home, Midland. He was born to Vincent and Eva (Tabaka) Paciorkowski on December 28, 1907 in Bay City, where he resided most of his life. Al was a Veteran of the U.S. Army, serving our country during WW II. Before his retirement, he was employed with the State of Michigan for thirty-four years. Al was a member of St. Stanislaus Kostka Parish and its Senior Citizens Club, and also a member of the Michigan Sheriffs Association.

He was married to the former Mata Domm, and she preceded him in death on May 11, 1980. Surviving family members include three sisters: Regina Pletzke and Sybil Dudley of Bay City, and Bobby Buck of CA; along with several nieces and nephews. Al was also predeceased by a son, Frederic A. Pakowski (1971), a brother, Edmund "Feathers" Paciorkowski, and a sister, Isabel Wongrowski.

A Memorial Mass will be celebrated Thursday, November 14, 1996 at 10:00 A.M. in the St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, with Rev. Loren M. Kalinowski presiding. Cremation will take place and interment of Al's remains will be in St. Stanislaus Kostka Cemetery following the church service, with Military Rites by the Bay County Veterans Council.
