As part of FOP Lodge 12, we will include Sturgis Williams Middle School. This year is the 2nd year of Operation for Stagebarn Middle School. Currently, there are 439 children attending Stagebarn Middle School.

The children will shop with an Officer and will be allowed to purchase basic need items, like blankets, clothes, shoes, school supplies, and hygiene items. We are hoping to provide each child with \$100 dollars to shop. The child will be allowed to purchase gifts for their family members, after \$50 dollars is spent on themselves.

The children will then go to the HillsView Church to wrap gifts, decorate cookies, play games, and eat pizza.

We select the most deserving of children to participate. Last year was a huge success, thanks to our thoughtful donors and volunteers.

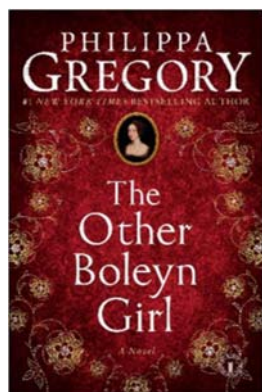
