This week we had a Planning and Zoning meeting and City Council meeting. The RV ordinance is now further along. Phillip and the P&Z board did an amazing job working on this. Thank you. Our city council meeting was a success. The council approved the resolutions needed for our road grant on May, Locust and Walnut Streets. We have budgeted for this road grant during the budget last fall now we are in the final engineering phases and ready to start the construction soon. Hopefully this August.

We are starting the budget and tax season again as we have for the past two years. Each department is working on their budget and getting ready to propose soon. Once we get county information, we can start the budget tax hearings and approval of the budget. We are very mindful of what the county is doing in regards to their budget for next year, especially for COVID-19 virus impact on our economy.

Library staff have been busy prepping to reopen the library. They're still waiting on some equipment, but have been busy weeding the collection to make room for 300 new titles purchased with funds from the J. Frank Dobie Trust. Lots of new chapter books, juvenile fiction, graphic novels, and more are in now in the catalog. You can place reserves online, by phone, or email, and pick up materials weekdays from 1-5 p.m.

Our EMS has initiated new narcotics procedures and forms. Jeff's been working on obtaining the last ambulance quote for a grant. Jeff will be continuously monitoring for newly opened grant opportunities.

COVID-19: As Texas continues opening up for business, businesses should follow simple guidelines to ensure a safe and clean environment for employees as well as customers. The Public Works department worked on three leaks, and set up for Monday and Tuesday night's meeting. They have been cutting trees over the roadway around town and will continue to be doing this every week. They also worked on the booster station at Well #4 and removed a tree in the park. They mowed in these areas this past week: the tower behind the Sonic, Well #6, museum, train depo and the empty lot in front of city hall. They also took care of the wasted sludge at sewer plant.

Our Police Department have been working on turning cases into the District Attorney Office. NIBRS Reports submitted for May. Enhance training for all officers for higher licensing. Chief is scheduling classes for Officer O'Neal and Sgt. West that are required.
