This tournament will observe the rules and regulations of participation established by the Ohio High School Athletic Association. This all-star tournament is open to All Conferences in the South West Ohio area of the Ohio High School Athletic Association.

Qualifying Round: All teams will bowl two (2) team games followed by 2 Baker games. Based on the total scores from the Qualifying Round, teams in each division will be seeded for the Championship Round. All ties for teams will be broken by highest baker score. Qualifying Round lane assignments will be determined by the tournament manager. The scores from the Qualifying Round will only be used to determine the seeding for the Championship Round and to determine five (5) individual members of the all-tournament team in each division. The scores from the Qualifying Round do not carry over to the Championship Round. Teams will move one pair following each individual game and one time for bakers.

Championship Round: The Championship Round will consist of a best 2 of 3 baker game bracketed format. Ties for advancing teams will be broken by a 9th-10th frame roll-off Awards: The 1st and 2nd place teams in each division will receive recognition. The members of the 1 st $\& 2 n d$ place teams will each receive recognition.

All Star Teams: There shall be no more than 8 players on a team. Teams are to be determined by the individual conferences/ divisions. Conferences may submit a team based on how the conference determines first/second team awards. For example: the GWOC has 1 conference, 4 divisions, and 2 teams of Awards (American and National). They may choose as a conference to submit 1 conference team, 2 teams (American and National), or 4 teams based on Division. The GCL South has 1 division and would only submit one team. All teams should be considered before sending more than 3 players from an individual high school should appear on the all-star team. If a conference/division would like to submit a secondary team, that may be permitted (For example: GCL 1, GCL 2). Secondary teams will be per-mitted on a first come first serve basis if other conferences do not submit a team. Teams must be submitted by Friday March 22nd. After March 22nd submitted $2^{\text {nd }}$ teams will be used to fill the field. Teams may be built based on conference coaches' decisions: high-est conference averages, highest tournament averages, coaches vote, etc

Coaches: The coaching staff for the all-star team shall be determined by the coaches of conference/division itself. Some divisions or conferences may choose to have the "Coach of the Year" coach the team. Only 2 coaches per team will be allowed in the bowlers' area. Other coaches will be requested to stay in the stands and follow OHSAA fan expectations.

Uniforms: The individual team members will be encouraged to wear their school's bowling uniform. If they are unable to wear their uniform, then a non-descript shirt or polo with their schools colors shall be permitted. Bowling jerseys from makers such as Storm, Logoinfusion, etc may also be permitted. Rules on uniforms will be enforced, no jeans/shorts/etc. Teams may create and use a conference Logo attached to their uniforms if they would like.

Playing Time: This is a competitive event that is also used to showcase the talent in our area. All bowlers on your roster MUST throw at least one ball during the seeding portion of the tournament ( 2 individual games and 2 baker games). All Scores will be given to the starting bowler. A fill ball will not penalize the starter.

Cost: Free for the all-star teams competing. Spectator admission is $\$ 8.00$, Children 6 and under are free. Each All-Star team can admit a maximum of 8 uniformed bowlers and 2 coaches at no charge.
