

*Please, **BE WATER WISE***


Consider vacuum assisted, low volume toilets.

Do not use the toilet as a waste basket. Not only do advertised "flushables" not degrade, they clog system pipes and waster water with each flush.

Avoid tank tablet toilet cleaners. They erode rubber and plastic parts and cause leaks.

Before irrigation season, replace broken or missing sprinkler heads.

Renozzle/spray head with rotator type nozzles.

Firewise Landscaping



Use fire resistant plants and non-flammable hardscape elements like rock walls instead of wood chip mulches.

Store firewood away from your home and other structures.

Provide 10-12' spacing between trees and shrubs.

Remove ladder fuels like shrubs beneath trees. Remove tree limbs 6-10' from ground.
