Huntington City Dumpster Site

Please separate your items when taking to the dumpsite. Put all metal in the metal dumpster. Branches, clean wood, and leaves can be put in the burn area. The site will be closed while the dumpsters are being emptied or if the dumpsters are full. Debris from contractors and vehicles larger than a pickup truck will not be allowed to use the dumpsters. The following are **not allowed** and you will need to take them to the County Landfill: **Refrigerators, A/C units, batteries, tires, oils, fluids and other moistures, contaminated soil and large rocks.** For questions on items you are not sure about, call the Emery County Landfill at 381-2719.
