THIS IS NOT A COMPETITION; it is an opportunity for young people to creatively explore this topic through whatever art form they would like.

Make a work of art from your trash!

Take some things you would ordinarily throw away – plastic bottles or containers, glass, electronics, paper, cardboard... and make them into art!

Show off your best work in this exhibit.

We call upon our young people, ages 4-16, to create a piece of art using recycled materials as part or all of the work.

GUIDELINES FOR ENTRY:

1. This exhibit will include artwork from people ages 4 to 16
2. Each young person may submit one piece of art made from recycled materials.
3. Any type of materials may be used, including paint, markers, other drawing materials, recycled items in the form of sculpture, and more.
4. Any work intended to hang on a wall must be framed, with a wire or other hanging hardware on the back.
5. Both parts of the entry form should be filled out in their entirety, with the upper part affixed to the artwork and the lower part handed in with the artwork.
6. TO BE INCLUDED IN THE EXHIBIT, ARTWORK MUST BE DROPPED OFF ON Saturday, May 18 or Sunday, May 19, between 11am and 1pm.

Be creative, do your best work, think deeply, and have fun! We look forward to seeing the results of your effort.
