New Online Resources

On our website we have a tab called online resources. Under this tab you will find many different databases we have available for our patrons to access. There are two databases that you are only able to access them while using one of the computers at the library. The first one is KYVL Career Preparation. This online resource will help you prepare for a career exam, look at different occupations and also improve workplace skills. To use this resource you do have to create an account.

The second database that is only accessible by using one of our public computers is Ancestry Library Edition. It is powered by Ancestry.com and you are able to search census data, vital records, directories, photos and more. This is an online genealogy resource that we will have available to our patrons by the end of March.

We have two new online resources that will be available to our patrons when they are at the library or when they are home. The first one is America's News. It is a database where you can search current and archived articles from news sources across the United States. In this database you can search specific articles, statistics, staff written coverage of local and national topics, obituaries, video clips, quotations, facts and analysis. This resource will be accessible on our website and you will need to use your library card number to login.

The second one is AtoZ World Food. This database has different recipes for every country, along with information about the different food cultures in every country. Each country has a page that has traditional recipes in seven categories. Those categories are appetizers, soups, salads, breads, main courses, side dishes, desserts and beverages. The food cultures for each country are also divided into six categories. They are national cuisine, regional cuisine, daily meals, dining etiquette, special occasion food and food trivia. To be able to access all this information, you will just need to login using your library card number.

Be sure to check our website throughout the month to see if there are any new online resources added. Hopefully by the end of the month all our new online resources will be on our website ready to go.

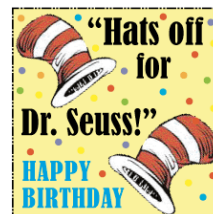
