

You Must Bring your own Eye and Ear Protection
DENVER PD RETIREE CCW QUALIFICATION DAY

WHERE: 3421 Park Ave West, Denver Police Indoor Range.

WHEN: From 7am to 4pm. We break for lunch from 11 to 12am. We're usually slowest in the late afternoon and busiest mid-morning, so plan accordingly.

WHAT'S EXPECTED – SAFETY: All pistols MUST be cleared and locked back, no magazine in them, at the orange clearing barrels outside the front door *before* you come in. Do not remove your weapon from the holster or case until told to do so by range staff. Pistols must remain VISIBLY EMPTY (slide locked back, no magazine) at all times. Revolvers must be holstered or cased. Do not point your weapon, loaded or unloaded, at yourself or anyone else.

**FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE RULES, OR ANY SAFETY VIOLATION, WILL RESULT IN YOUR
EXPULSION FROM THE RANGE.**

WHAT TO BRING: Bring your gun, spare magazines or speed loaders, and holster. Bring eye and ear protection and a mask. Bring 50 rounds of ammunition if it's a caliber we don't provide. Bring your driver's license, retired ID, and old CCW permit. We do not take your money – you will pay when you pick up your permit.

NEW CHANGE – FILL OUT, PRINT Forms. BRING IN YOUR OWN COMPLETED PAPERWORK.

WHAT'S PROVIDED: Assistance in properly filling out forms if necessary. We provide ammunition for 9mm, .45 ACP, and .38 Special only.

WHAT HAPPENS NEXT: We will forward your paperwork to the Denver CCW office for H.R. 218 permits if you live in or retired from Denver.

For outside agencies we will send in the paperwork only if you live in Denver – if not, you take it to your agency or county of residence.

For state permits we can only process Denver residents, others take the paperwork to your county.
