

An ordinance levying corporate taxes in the city of Garnett, Kansas, and special paving assessments for the city of Garnett for the fiscal year 1928.

Be it ordained by the governing body of the city of Garnett, Kansas:

Section 1. That there be levied corporate taxes for the various city purposes and to pay interest on the bonded indebtedness of the said city, and to create sinking funds to pay the bonded indebtedness of said city on each one hundred dollars valuation of all taxable property, in the city of Garnett Kansas, for the fiscal year 1928, as follows:

Section 2. That a special assessment is hereby made on all lots and pieces of ground in paving districts liable for special assessments for paving as follows, to-wit:

To pay one tenth (1-10) of the original assessments and five per cent (5%) interest on seven-tenths (7-10) of the original assessment on east Fourth Avenue for one year between blocks 36 and 45, 37 and 44, 38 and 43, 39 and 42, and on Olive street between blocks 39 and 40, 22 and 21, 19 and 20, 2 and 1, and between blocks 1 and 2 in Chapin's Addition to the city of Garnett:

Also to pay one tenth (1-10) of the original assessment and four and ~~fourths~~ ^{one half} per cent (4 1/2%) interest on seven-tenths (7-10) for one year of the original assessment, between blocks 59 and 62, 58 and 63, 57 and 64, 56 and 65, 55 and 66, 54 and 67, 53 and 68, 52 and 69, 51 and 70 on Sixth Avenue, and on Maple street between block 70 and Block 1 in Smith's Addition to the city of Garnett, Kansas, and on west Third Avenue between blocks 26 and 35, 27 and 34, 28 and 33, 29 and 32, 30 and 31:

Also to pay one tenth (1-10) of the original assessment and four and three fourths (4 3/4%) interest ~~on~~ for one year on eight-tenths (8-10) of the original assessment on Sixth Avenue between blocks 1 in Smith's Addition to the city of Garnett and block 1 in Farris' addition to the city of Garnett and on Elm Street between blocks 32 and 33, 49 and 48, 52 and 53 and 69 and 68, and on Walnut Street between blocks 53 and 34, 48 and 47, 54 and 53, 68 and 67, and on Main Street between blocks 35 and 36, Pine Street between blocks 44 and 45, and on East Fifth Avenue between blocks 45 and 56 and on Maple Street

between blocks 10, 11, 30 and 31 in the city of Garnett and blocks, lots, pieces and parcels of ground in Orchard Park and New Orchard Park additions to the city of Garnett liable for assessment for paving, and on Main Street between blocks 55 and 56 and between blocks 35 and 36, and on east Third Avenue between blocks 25 and 36 and 24 and 37, and on Second Avenue between blocks 16, and 25, 15 and 26, 14 and 27, 13 and 28, 12 and 29, 11 and 30, and on Vine street between blocks 31 and 32, 50 and 49, 51 and 52, 70 and 69, 71 and 72, and in Chapman's addition to the city of Garnett between blocks 4 and 5, 7 and 6 and 14 and 15;

Also, to pay one tenth (1-10) of the original assessment and four and one-half percent interest (4½%) for one year on nine tenths (9-10) of the original assessment on First Avenue between blocks 6 and 15, 7 and 14, 8 and 13, 9 and 12, 10 and 11, and on east Second Avenue between blocks 17 and 24, 18 and 23, 19 and 22, and on Pine street between blocks 36 and 37, 25 and 24, and on High Street between blocks 1 and 2 in Smith's addition to the city of Garnett.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after ten days after its final passage and publication in the Garnett Review.
