

Ordinance No. 649.

An Ordinance to establish and maintain a system of street lighting on certain streets in the City of Garnett, Kansas, Such as is commonly called a "White Way"

Be it ordained by the ~~xxxxxx~~ Mayor and Board of Commissionere of the City of Garnett, Kandas.

Section 1. That there shall be established in the City of Garnett, in accordance with plans and specifications on file with the City Clerk in said city, and on the streets in said plans and specifications indicated, a system of electric lights on poles of five light design and ~~and~~ at points designated, on the said streets as shown in said plans. Provided ~~that the~~ the cost of erecting, establishing and constructing said system shall be fully paid for by popular subscription, or by other means other than by taxation therefor.

Section 2. That ~~as~~ <sup>as</sup> said system pf electric lighting provided for in ~~the~~ Section one of this ordinance shall ~~be~~ be ~~established~~ established constructed and ready for operation, the said city of Garnett shall at its own expence operate, maintain and care for the same, and that said system shall be thereafter, owned, controled and used as other property of said city, and that said system shall be operated as an all-night service of lighting in said city, Provided certain lights may be cut out from each pole or on such poles as may be designated by resolution, by the mayor and board of commissioners.

Section 3. That if all of said lighting system can not at once be arranged for, as provided in said plans and specifications, that the said system may be completed, in as near the same style <sup>and</sup> character as possible as originally commenced.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be inforce from and after its passage and publication according to law.
