

We were told that the C8 would probably arrive in Canada in November, but it would be for G.M. media and dealer promotion only. For all of you C8 enthusiasts, it is going to be a while yet before you can get behind the wheel of Corvette's new supercar.

It was a day of past, present, and future – remembering friends, making new friends, and looking forward to the future.





Thompson won numerous races in the late 50's and 60's, taking the SCCA championship in 1956, 1957, 1960, 1961 and 1962. NATIONAL CORVETTE MUSEUM NAMED "BEST MUSEUM IN KENTUCKY"

The "Best in Kentucky" Awards are a celebration of hometowns, people and places that make Kentucky a great place to live and visit. Voting takes place annually with awards presented at the Kentucky State Fair.

Recently the National Corvette Museum was named 'Best Museum' for 2019. The Museum's Director of Marketing and Communications, Katie Ellison, said "We are thrilled that so many of our fans supported us by casting their votes. Visitors travel from all over the globe to visit the Home of Corvette and we are proud to represent Kentucky as the Best Museum."

2019 CORVETTE STATS RELEASED

When Chevrolet released the final stats for the 2019 model year it came as no surprise that Arctic White was again the most popular colour of Corvette purchased.

A total of 34,822 Vettes were produced at the Bowling Green Assembly Plant. 39.3% of those were Stingrays, 32.3% were Grand Sports, 19.9% were Z06s and 8.5% were ZR1s. 27,017 cars (or 77.6%) were automatic transmission; and overall, coupes outsold convertibles at 84% *and* within each model type! Here are the exterior colours sorted by volume:

Black (6,164) Torch Red (4,848) Sebring Orange (2,980) Dark Shadow Gray (2,519) Long Beach Red (2,397) Elkhart Lake Blue (2,166) Blade Silver (1,844) Ceramic Matrix Gray (1,581) Watkins Glen Gray (1,415) Corvette Racing Yellow (1,291) Admiral Blue (828)

Corvette Racing competed on the US west coast at Laguna Seca in mid-September hoping and aiming for their 100th victory to stay in contention for a fourth GTLM championship. In 20 races at Laguna Seca since 1999, our team accumulated almost 12,000 racing miles and more than 5,300 racing laps.

Qualifying would see the No. 3 Corvette start Sunday's race in sixth position with the No. 4 Corvette starting in seventh. All eight GTLM cars finished qualifying within 0.738 seconds. On race day, both Corvettes would rebound from their disappointing qualifying efforts.

The team's 3-stop strategy to maximize tire performance at the expense of an extra stop paid off on race day. The strategy also allowed Milner to set the fastest GTLM lap of the race. Antonio Garcia and Jan Magnussen in the No. 3 Corvette landed in third place at race-end. Oliver Gavin and Tommy Milner, driving the No. 4 Corvette, placed fourth with each team gaining four positions from the first lap of the race to the finish.

Sunday's race results put Garcia and Magnussen third in points, and 15 points down from the Class leaders. Full race details and photos from Leguna Seca are available online from www.corvetteracing.com.

Corvette Racing closes the 2019 season with the **10-hour Petit Le Mans** race from Michelin Raceway Road Atlanta on **Saturday, October 12**.

Jordan Taylor to replace Jan Magnussen at Corvette Racing in 2020!!

Prior to September's Laguna Seca race it was reported that Jordan Taylor will replace Jan Magnussen for the 2020 racing season. This will be a bittersweet departure, but at the same time Corvette Racing fans can welcome an excellent, young driver in Jordan Taylor.

Jordan, age 28, will leave his father's *Wayne Taylor Racing* Cadillac DPi team to join Corvette Racing. Magnussen is 46 and his contract with GM ends at the close of the current season.

Jordan Taylor is no stranger to Corvette Racing. He was 3rd driver for the endurance races between 2012 and 2017, as well as co-driving the Corvette C6.R to victory at the 24 Hours of Le Mans in June 2015. In 2014 at Le Mans, Jordan achieved a runner-up finish.
