

A teller tabulates the weekly offering and makes the bank deposit. Tellers serve on two person teams which work on a monthly rotational basis.

Members of the Sound System team utilize their computer skills to operate the audio/visual presentation of the worship service. Also needed, is someone to help put together the weekly worship service on the church laptop for the projector. This job takes about 1 1/2 hours of your time. Training is minor.

What does an Acolyte do?

Acolyte - "follower" and "helper." Our supply of Acolytes is dwindling. Any member of CLC at any age can be an Acolyte. The acolyte is responsible for lighting & extinguishing the candles, carrying the cross, distributing the offering bowls, and assisting with Holy Communion and Baptisms.
