

YOUR MOTORCYCLE SKILL LEVEL

It is unfortunate that many motorcyclists are involved in crashes. In almost a third of all crashes the rider took no evasive action to avoid the crash or did so too late to avoid the crash. This statistic comes from a recent National Transportation Safety Board report on the causes of motorcycle crashes.

Rider education and on-road experiences stress the need for motorcyclists to pay strict attention to the road ahead and do their best to avoid dangerous situations before they occur. But motorcyclists are human, and distractions and/or a lack of riding skills can result in a crash.

So, what can be done to help a motorcyclist reduce the chances of being involved in a crash? Let's start with "A Basic Rider's Course." There are many things in that course to learn about besides just knowing how to physically maneuver a motorcycle. Knowing how you as a human react to different situation as well as how your motorcycle will react is very

helpful in saving you some grief. Many riders like me were self taught on how to ride which may have included being taught by an untrained rider. How do you know the information you are being given by that untrained person is correct? I was self taught to ride a motorcycle 28 years before I became a Motorcycle Instructor. When I went to Instructor's School I found out there were things I had been doing wrong and things I didn't know. I had a few mishaps on my bikes during my first 28 years of riding that could have been avoided had I first been given the proper instruction. I have been a MSF (Motorcycle Safety Foundation) Instructor now for 28 years which has been very beneficial to me as well as riders I have trained.

Another thing that can help a seasoned rider is to take a oneday motorcycle refresher course. Physical skills perish with time. You might say "I ride all the time so I don't need any refresher course." The physical skills that perish over time are not the casual everyday riding skills. It is the emergency maneuvers that you don't usually get a chance to practice. It is too late to find out during an emergency that you cannot react properly. The riding skills you must stay proficient in are: Emergency Braking, Swerving and Cornering. These are the type of exercises you will practice in a one-day riding course. What better place to practice these skills than on and empty safe parking lot. It is better to see how well you react in a

simulated situation with nothing to hit, rather than to improperly react in real traffic and slam into a car.

For the older riders the benefit of taking a refresher course is self assessment. See if you can still properly handle the machine you are riding. You might find you do not still possess the physical strength to control the bike you are on. You might realize that your current bike is now too heavy to hold up during stops. You might decide to go to a lighter bike or even to a threewheel motorcycle so you can continue to safely ride.

Two-wheel, Trike, Sport Bike and Adventure Bike Classes are all available. The internet is a wonderful thing. Just "Google" the type of class you want and you will find it there. The Tampa Police Motorcycle Unit conducts a one day riding course once a month. Some other agencies in our State also provide this service. They are: Collier County, Osceola County, Gainesville, Jacksonville, and Palm Beach County. The website to find an agency is: flmsp.com. It is paid for with a Florida State Grant. You bring your own bike and they will put you through exercises to refresh your riding skills. For the Tampa area Google: Tampa SMART-Safe Motorcycle and Rider Techniques Course and the site will come up with the sign-up page. The course is free. So, consider taking a one-day refresher Riding Course for your safety as well as the safety of the loved ones riding with you.

You do not have to be an instructor or professional speaker to participate. I will provide maximum support for you. The atmosphere in a presentation is very participative and relaxed, typically with 10-15 participants ready to listen and contribute as invited. Lack of public speaking experience should not deter anyone.

Just got back from the North Carolina rally...

OH MY GOODNESS!!! This one was the BEST one yet (sorry to all the others). We did have a great time (there is good, wonderful, and then there is GREAT). I'm still reliving the Las Vegas FUN; but I just can't get over the quarter action. What FUN, what FUN! I'll let the rest try to explain that to you, dear reader.

Hello Sherill (hope that's right). Anyway, as usual, I'm being an odd man out this month and deviating a little. With the season approaching, I'm going to give you some cooking tips that might help when you run short of something. By the way, this also includes all the men out there that cook too. HERE WE GO:

When baking a box mix, use unsalted butter, melted, instead of oil. Milk instead of water, add a few drops of vanilla. It'll taste bakery fresh.

Need heavy cream... mix 2/3 cup whole milk with 1/3 cup melted butter = 1 cup heavy cream.
