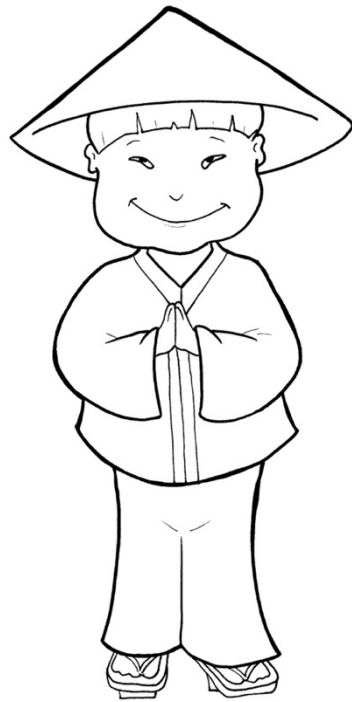


53. I am Alive: Tell the World

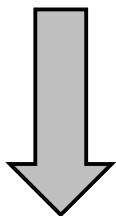
Questions

4. Think of one person in your life who does not know Jesus as Lord. Will you tell that person?

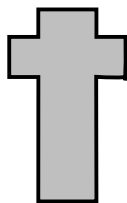
Dear Lord Jesus,

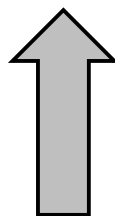
