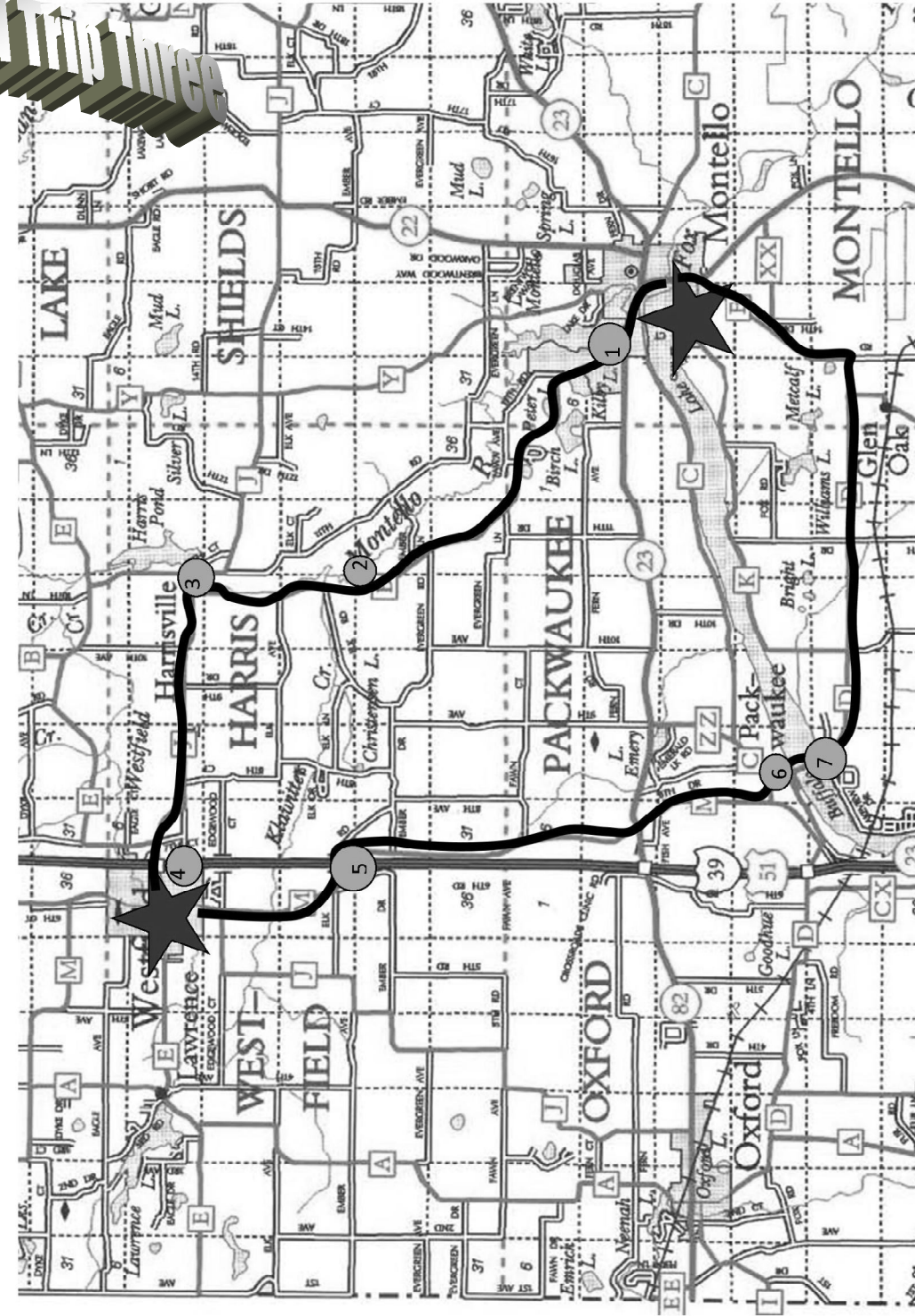


# Road Trip Ideas

## Our Howard and Betty trip to the Marquette County Historical Society



1. Montello is on both Buffalo Lake and Montello Lake. Montello Lake is a mill pond formed by damming the Montello River.
2. The Montello River runs along County Road B into Montello.
3. Harrisville also has a mill pond and a power plant on the Montello River, but some people call it the Crooked River.
4. County J goes under Interstate 39/51 into Westfield. Guess what....Westfield also has a mill pond on the same river! But here it is called Westfield Creek. The Marquette County Historical Society and Marquette County Fair are both in Westfield.
5. Now County Road M goes over I 39/51. Here's Packwaukee, home once to many Indians for thousands of years and the oldest settlement in Marquette County.
7. Cross over the causeway. Once a ferry took people to the other side of the lake which is really a widening of the Fox River.

★ You're back in Montello. Watch for the lock channel next to the Fox River dam that used to let big steam boats through. After that you cross the Montello River. ★
