

# The National Drive – Policy changes

## Camp site reservation policy

You may reserve the camp site of your choice, subject to availability, for the **National Drive Fall 2021** in one of two ways:

1. Give us a check (\$25 per night) along with your preferred site number & second choice.
2. Call us with your preferred site number & second choice. Then send us a check within 7 days.

(Payment is required to reserve campsites and we will not hold your check for deposit)

Camp sites available: 1-56, 60-70 (Campsites 17-32 are 30A/20A only)

(You may camp the night before the event (Monday) thru Sunday night)

**For 2022 and beyond, campsites will only be reserved on your paid registration form. First come, first served. Entries open with Feb 1<sup>st</sup> & July 1<sup>st</sup> postmarks, spring/fall respectively. No more advance reservations.**

## Registration Policy

Starting in 2020, the following changes will be implemented regarding registration timelines.

For the National Drive Spring:

Registrations will be accepted starting with February 1<sup>st</sup> postmark.

For the National Drive Fall:

Registrations will be accepted starting with July 1<sup>st</sup> postmark.

(Payment is required with registration and we will not hold your check for deposit)

**For 2022 and beyond, stalls will only be reserved with a paid registration form. First come, first served. Entries open with Feb 1<sup>st</sup> & July 1<sup>st</sup> postmarks, spring/fall respectively. No more “holding” stalls next to others without those entries.**

We will continue to accept registrations right up until the start of an event. As always, if you can't ensure your last-minute registration will reach us in time (10 days out), please contact us so we can hold a place for you. While we will not turn you away if you arrive during an event, we insist you give us a heads up that you may be coming, including your probable arrival date/time.
