

Death Summons Mrs. Mary Omich

Funeral services were set for 1:30 p. m. Thursday at Shetler Funeral home for Mrs. Mary W. Omich, 95, who died Monday at Schilling Nursing Home, after an illness of two months. Elder Archie Harder will officiate at the services, and burial will be in Souletown cemetery.

Mrs. Omich was born Mary W. Heddy on May 26, 1854, while her mother was on board a ship sailing from England to New York. Her family moved to Huron county when she was 15. She was married to Frank A. Omich in Saginaw in 1875.

They lived in Caseville and Chandler township, until Mr. Omich died December 17, 1910, after which she made her home with her two sons.

During her recent illness she was confined to Schilling Nursing Home. For her 95th birthday anniversary this past May, Mrs. Omich was feted at an open house celebration, when she was presented with flowers and gifts. At that time the above photograph was taken.

Mrs. Omich is survived by two son, Romain of the Quarry, and Charles of Flint, six grandchildren and 12 great grandchildren.
