Being Held the weekend of June the 4th, 5th, 6th & 7th in the year of our lord 2026. (Extended to early set up on the 4th)

Shooting Events: Black Powder only, patched round ball (except Muskets). No Grease Patch Lube Due to Fire Hazards!

Trail Walk: Any Traditional Muzzleloader. Trail Walks can be shot any time during the weekend. 3 separate classes, Flintlock, General and Trade Gun. (Medals awarded for all categories.) You can shoot all three if you desire. **A bonus trail walk can be shot for an additional \$5 entry fee that is an extended walk being offered for the first time this year!** Pot Luck Dinner on Saturday bring some meet and fresh vegetables (no Frozen) if you would like to participate.

Offhand Matches: Assorted 25 to 50 yard off hand matches shot anytime during the weekend.

Primitive 3d archery Trail Walk: Shoot your longbow or re curve or use a loaner .3D and square targets at different distances.

Team Fort Shoot: Get your team of 3 shooters together ,plan a strategy and knock down all of the targets in the shortest time frame, shot all day Saturday and Sunday morning.

Pistol: Gong Challenge (can be shot at anytime during the weekend). (Medals awarded.)

Knife & Hawk: Various size targets recreational only no competition.

Camping: Primitive and Modern available —outhouses on site—bring your own water. Pets must be on a leash, please follow the “pack it in pack it out rule” Period dress encouraged , but not mandatory.

Registration: \$20.00 Fee per person. 16 and under free..

Directions: From 1-90 take exit 289, go south on Pines (becomes SR27) for 8.3 miles, turn left onto Belmont Road, go through the town of Mica and continue for 1.7 miles, turn left onto Chapman Rd (gravel) look for Rendezvous signs go about 500 feet and turn right onto a dirt road that goes through a grass field . This is a rough dirt and grass roads that dead ends into the Rendezvous site.
