<sup>2</sup>Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your minds, so that you may discern what is the will of God — what is good and acceptable and perfect...4For as in one body we have many members, and not all the members have the same function, 5so we, who are many, are one body in Christ, and individually we are members one of another. <sup>6</sup>We have gifts that differ according to the grace given to us: prophecy, in proportion to faith; <sup>7</sup>ministry, in ministering; the teacher, in teaching; <sup>8</sup>the exhorter, in exhortation; the giver, in generosity; the leader, in diligence; the compassionate, in cheerfulness. Romans 12

As your shepherd, I see God revealing Himself to us as we begin to dream and wonder how we will be transformed in 2019. The will of God IS perfect! Paul uses the word,  $\mu \epsilon \lambda o \varsigma$ , which is translated here as "member." Since "member" might suggest, "independence, wholeness" I would rather use the "limb" because we are dependent on one another in the body of Christ. *4For as in one body we have many limbs, and not all the limbs have the same function.* Mt Hermon needs **your limb**! We need to hear your dreams and your visions. We need to depend on each other for gifts, ministry, teaching, and generosity.
