Google Hangouts Meet

Google is offering free access to the Hangouts Meet video conferencing capabilities to all G Suite customers globally from now until July 1, 2020. Features of G Suite include:

- Larger meetings, for up to 250 participants per call
- Live streaming for up to 100,000 viewers within a domain
- The ability to record meetings and save them to Google Drive

Microsoft Teams

Following Google's footsteps, Microsoft also showed their concern over the pandemic and suggested that they will offer a **free six-month trial** for the premium tier of Microsoft Teams, globally. The Office 365 E1 tier offers web-based Office apps and business services, along with email, file storage and sharing, meetings, and instant messaging. Until now, the tier was being offered for a premium, however, after taking into account the coronavirus outbreak, the company decided to lift off the restrictions to non-premium users to encourage more people to work from home.
