From the Minister's Mac

"In Memory of Rev. Bob Link"

Last weekend a former pastor of mine, Rev. Bob Link, was laid to rest. I wasn't able to attend the service, but if I had been there, I would have told this story about him — the very thing that made him one of my favorite pastors.

One Sunday, Bob made the announcement that the city had complained about the weeds growing in our extra lot. He asked for volunteers to show up the following Saturday to help tidy up the lot so we would be good neighbors.

Of course, I forgot. That Saturday, rushing home from the grocery store with the kids in tow, I drove past the church and saw Bob out in the field pulling weeds — all by himself! Mortified, we got the groceries put away, grabbed gardening tools and went to join him in his labor of love. By the time we got to the church, Bob was no longer alone. We happily joined the work detail and others continued to arrive. Many hands make light work and we whipped that field into shape in no time. But the weeding is not what I remember. What has stuck with me all these years is Bob's leadership by example, his willingness to do the work all by himself if necessary, and the way he inspired so many to drop the plans they had for the day and spend the morning working together.

Bob was also the kind of pastor who insisted on not being paid when there wasn't enough money to cover other payroll and expenses. The chair of SPRC would get up Sunday morning, explain the situation, and ask folks to "dig deep so we can pay the pastor." And we did, in spite of his protests.

Rev. Bob Link was a man who devoted his life to Love. I know we all hope to do the same!




Adult Bible Study
