In my sermons and newsletter articles I've been talking about the "theology of the Cross," in which we as Lutheran-Christians (and various stripes and shades of L-Cs!) discern a spirit and method, a dynamic at work:

- The Cross is about **God's initiative in Jesus**, the Christ/Messiah; •
- it is about God's grace, that is, divine, unconditional love for us and all the "cosmos" (see John . 3:16) made incarnate, that is, "fleshly" and human in Jesus;
- and it is about God in Christ's suffering love (think "Cross") for the Other, the one different from • me, the one on the edge of things, the one who is not necessarily loveable, which in God's eyes makes them oddly enough, the most loveable.

Note well, please, the subject in all of these bullet points: **God.** The theology of the Cross begins with God's compassion and suffering love for us (Martin Luther: pro nobis! For us!) We are the objectsubject of God's initiatives. God acts, God moves, God makes all things new.

That's where we begin and that's where we end all things – with God. In love.

As we wind down the "busy seasons" of the Church year, let's keep in mind the theology of the Cross God through Jesus loves, acts, dies and rises that we might experience the divine forgiveness, life and salvation.

FYI – please keep the Pacifica Synod of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in your prayers. This year we meet in Irvine, California, May 5-7, to elect a new bishop and honor Bishop Murray Finck for his eighteen years of service as bishop.
