

Design Guide – Huddle Meeting Space



Huddle/Presentation Meeting Space

Huddle Spaces can provide informal drop-in meeting locations for teams of 2-6 people as well as formal spaces for the smaller meeting location. These spaces can support simple wired and/or wireless display connections for laptops and mobile devices. Adding a PC with a usb mic and camera can enable applications such as Skype and Blue Jeans for video conferencing - or add one of the new generation of micro VC codecs such as the Polycom Debut. Network access could enable web applications as well as access to network drives for network based applications.

Crestron HD-MD-400-c-e provides Auto-Switching as well as an internal scaler – no more changing of resolutions. As well as HDMI (2) and VGA + Audio access at the desk there is a further HDMI input at the display allowing easy inclusion of a wireless media device or network PC in addition to a single HDMI output to the display.

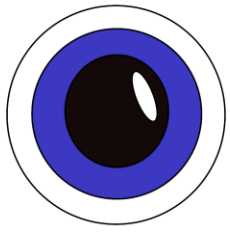
Desk cables can be neatly terminated and presented at the desk with the Crestron TT-100 pictured opposite.

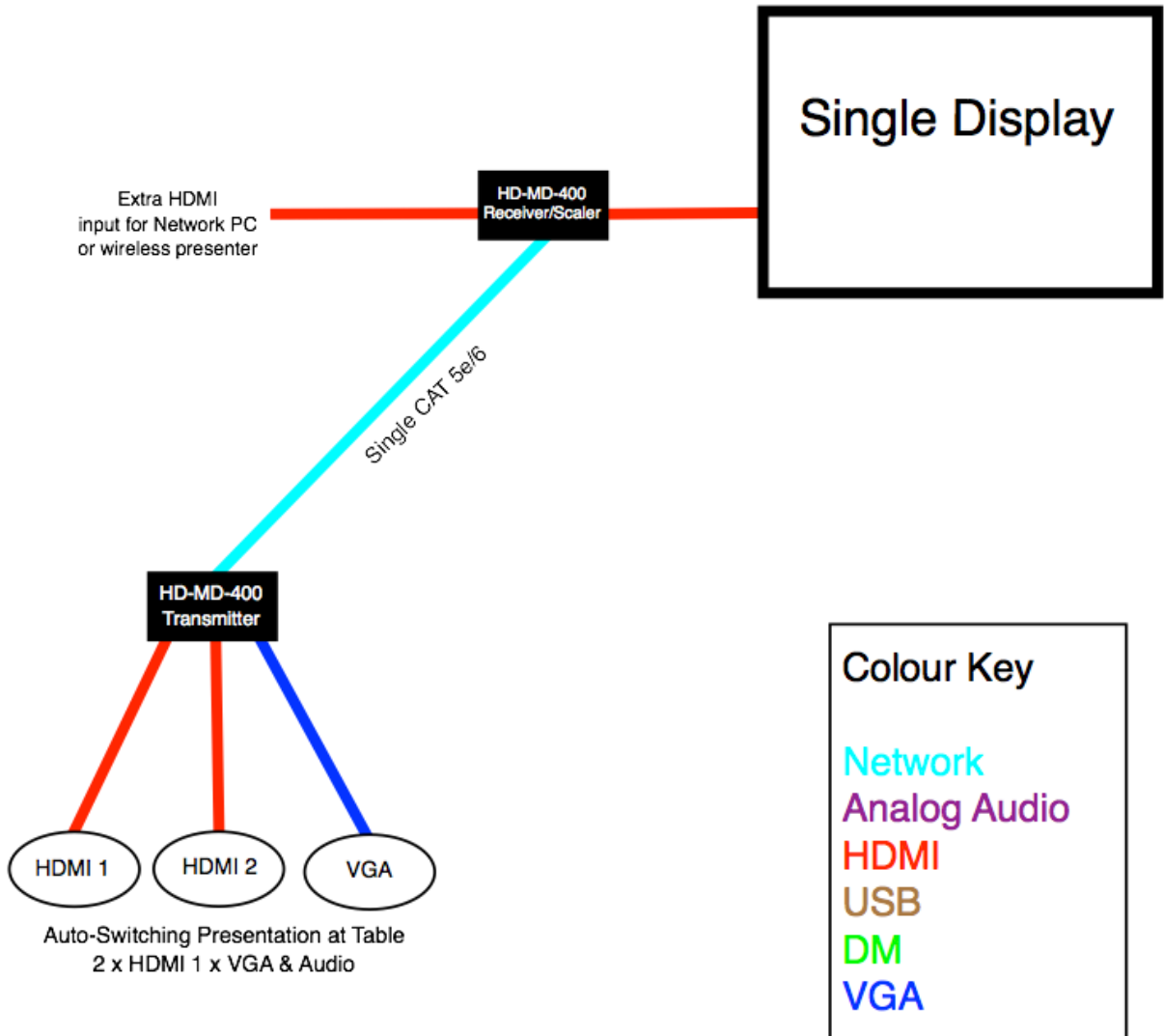
