Edgar F. Luckhard, 76 of Saginaw, passed away Aug. 27 following a brief illness.

Mr. Luckhard was born May 13, 1920 to Charles F. and Rose (Votz) Luckhard of Bach. He was baptized into the Christian faith in 1920 at St. Peter's Lutheran Church of Bach and affirmed his baptismal vows at confirmation there on May 13, 1934.
