

A RESIDENT OF PIGEON ¹⁹⁷⁰ FOR 49 YEARS, DIES

Gustave A. Wurtz, 76, passed away at his home in Pigeon Friday morning following an illness of two years. He was stricken to his bed a week before his death.

Mr. Wurtz was born at Bairsbronn Oberamt Freudenstadt, Germany. At the age of 18 he immigrated to Morrilton, Ontario. He came from there to Pigeon 49 years ago, and spent the remainder of his life here. He was a brick mason by trade and followed that occupation.

On August 29, 1905 he was united in marriage with Carrie Faist of Crediton, Ontario.

Besides his widow he leave a son Lloyd of Flint and two grandchildren; also one brother, Ernest of Winsor township.

The funeral service was conducted by Rev. Sumner Young, the local pastor, in the Evangelical church Sunday afternoon. Burial was in the Pigeon cemetery.
