Volunteers on her team prepare the altar, clean the pews, dust and clean the areas, prepare the elements for the Eucharist, order and maintain supplies including candles, and communion kits which are blessed, filled and made ready for Stephen Ministers They also keep a record of how many commune at each of the services. The Altar Guild must be familiar with the liturgical year including color sequence, symbols, and special days, placing and replacing seasonal banners and paraments, as well as care for altar flowers, providing assistance for baptisms, weddings, and funerals. Many tasks are done on Saturday morning, leaving cleaning for after services on Sunday.



The 2020 Entertainment Books are here and available for purchase at the Welcome Desk.

The Entertainment Book is great for:

- Travel almost anywhere, with big savings on restaurants, snack-shops, shopping, sporting activities, and services such as oil changes, dry cleaning, haircuts, etc.,
- Gifts for the holidays, birthdays or almost any occasion,
- Out-of-town family members and friends. Books can be ordered for most major cities, and shipped to their home address or delivered to Trinity. However, the price of out-of-town Entertainment Books varies by city with prices noted on a special order form at the Welcome Desk. The EB's can also be ordered online with Trinity still getting credit for the sale. More to follow on this.
- The Entertainment Books sell for \$25, which is a discount of \$10 off the regular price. Make your check payable to Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Church, and write "Entertainment Book" on the memo line.
- You don't have to wait until 2020 to start saving, because the Entertainment Card and the coupons can be used immediately. However, don't forget to use the coupons in your 2019 Entertainment Book first because most of them are good until the end of December.
- Again, we need to have everyone's help to make the 2020 Entertainment Book Fundraising Program a success.


