

Trip Report

Trip Name: Turkey Trek, Corral Creek Ridge and Brazeau

Mountain.

Date: Oct 25-26/14

1. **Logistics** – Hotel, travel,

- a. 10/12 stayed at Shunda Creek Hostel on Friday and 11/12 on Saturday night.
- b. 2/12 drove out Saturday am. One drove home after Saturdays potluck.

Weather.

a. Day started out at 1 degree, the clouds broke at noon. The sun warmed up to 8 degrees. Great hiking weather.

3. Trail Head Logistics:

- a. There are no outhouses at the trail head but lots of trees. Plan your stop prior.
- b. Parking lot is the first area past the helicopter staging area. It is just north of the Cline River Bridge.

Day 1 Hike

4. Trial;

- a. We took a wrong trail on off the right horse trial. We ended up above the via ferrate. Used up a couple hours but had a great view up and down Abraham Lake
- b. We made our way back to the trail cairn and took the proper trail to the Corral Creek viewing area. Had lunch in the sun and felt like we had put in a day.
- c. We were only getting started as we found our way to the trail up Corral Creek Ridge, there is various ways up but we stuck to the faint trail. It is marked with cairns.
- d. The last 2 km was an easy bush whack and not to steep. We had a little snow closer to the top but nothing more than 1inch deep.

5. The View,

- a. From the top of the ridge, there is a good view of Cline River, Corral Creek and the south end of Abraham Lake.
- b. We could clearly see where we made our trail mistake in the morning.
- c. Some went a little further on to Mount Stelford, it is only 30mins to the view over Stelford. (and another 30min to the summit) There is a great view up and down Abraham Lake with all the peaks and everything else that Western Canada has to offer.

6. Day 1, Wrap up;

a. Snow covered peaks and crisp air reminded us that the season was coming to an end.

- b. We returned to the hostel at 5:30.
- c. Hot tub, steak, salmon, wine and a more than we could eat potluck was enjoyed by all.

7. Hostel,

8. Trail,
