This is an intermediate or advanced level program. Applicants for this program should have a working knowledge of herbal medicine. Specifically you should be familiar with the medicinal uses of 60 to 100 herbs and their actions, have an understanding of basic anatomy and physiology, know how to make herbal preparations such as tinctures, salves, and water extracts, and have some experience using herbal remedies to treat specific health conditions. This program emphasizes the practice of clinical herbalism. The program is designed to build skills needed to safely and effectively practice as clinical herbalist.
