ATTENTION MEMBERS—Weekly Maintenance Crew Needs One Volunteer

An important part of the club's lead management activities is our "Weekly Maintenance" program that is implemented by four volunteer members. Unfortunately, one of our regular crewmen is forced to resign from the program due to a knee injury. The program includes four 1-hour-per-week maintenance projects that are rotated through by each of the crewmen. They include; 1. Mopping the range floor, 2. Mopping the office and backroom floors, 3. Dusting all range and office horizontal surfaces, and 4. Scrubbing the wash room fixtures and dusting all storage room surfaces. The program runs about 30 weeks during the indoor league season and is done at the convenience of the crew member's schedules. These volunteer hours cover the entire annual membership dues for each participant. Southport Gun Club, Inc. is a private not-for-profit membership organization, established in 1954 to promote the shooting sports. The Club features a regulation 50-foot, 10-lane, indoor range with turning targets, suitable for Precision Pistol and Small Bore Rifle shooting. Firearm safety training and competitive leagues and competitions are sponsored by the club. All members must also be NRA members.

CCW Training Policy Reminders

A number of members are providing firearms safety classes for concealed carry weapons training. Any member providing training for personal monetary gain must carry the NRA \$1M liability insurance with Southport Gun Club, Inc., named as also insured.

Please remember:

- CCW programs may not interfere with member access to the range.
 Note: NRA courses do have priority over member access.
- All participants must sign the Release and Indemnification form.
- A \$10.00 maintenance donation is asked for live fire exercises.
- Guns to be introduced to the shooting line must be brought in unloaded and in a case. Muzzles must remain pointed down-range at all times.
- Use of ECU's (empty chamber indicators) is required.
- All shooting on this range must be done from behind the yellow line.
 Note: an adjustable-height target holder may be placed between the yellow line and the bullet trap. to minimize damage to the plywood back plash panels, please use lanes #1 and #10 for CCW exercises.
- No "quick draw," "shooting from the hip" or "spray and pray."
- No human images or human-like silhouette targets may be posted.
- More than 5 shooters requires additional range safety officers.

Mid-range Target Placement for Safety

Because the ballistic steel in the bullet trap is comprised of 10 separate plates, there are gaps between them. The top of these plates are located about 10 inches below the top of the trap, thus creating another sharp edge. To protect the trap and minimize bullet splatter, it is imperative that all shots are carefully aimed at a target that is placed on the target holders. TO AVOID INJURY FROM BULLET SPLATTER, ALL SHOOTING MUST BE DONE FROM BEHIND THE YELLOW LINE!

If a mid-range target holder is used, it must be positioned so that the target is located directly between the individual shooters eye and the center of a ballistic steel plate. As shown in the photo at the right, the target must be posted exactly centered under one of the lane numbers that are just above the trap. It must also be located at the same visual height (or lower) than the target holders either side of the adjacent lanes.
