

ORDINANCE No: 2020-2

AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE, REPEAL, AND RECREATE
CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 7 OF THE VILLAGE OF ARLINGTON
CODE OF ORDINANCES REGARDING DOG LICENSE LATE FEES

WHEREAS, The Village Board of the Village of Arlington, Columbia County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

1. The Following Section 7.04 is repealed and amended as follows:

(f) **SECTION 7.04 Late Fees.**

The Village Clerk shall assess and collect a late fee of five dollars (\$5.00) from every owner of a dog five (5) months of age or over if the owner failed to obtain a license prior to April 1 of each year, or within thirty (30) days of acquiring ownership of a licensable dog or if the owner failed to obtain a license on or before the dog reached licensable age. An addition \$50.00 shall be assessed should owner not obtain a license prior to May 1 of each year. Subsequent violations will be \$150 (30 days after initial offense). Said late fees shall be charged in addition to the required license fees.


Severability of Provisions. Should any section, sentence, phrase or other portion of this Ordinance be declared invalid, such portion shall be deemed as a separate and distinct provision and shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Effective date. This Ordinance shall take effect and be enforced upon its passage and publication or posting as provided by law. Except as provided herein, all of the terms and provisions of Chapter 7 of the Village of Arlington Code of Ordinances shall remain in full force and effect.
