



Lagoon Loan Fee...REMOVED!

Town Council approved the final installment to the loan on the Waste Water Treatment Facility! All customers on the sewer system will notice a monthly decrease of \$30.78, starting on the 03/31/2022 utility bill. The remaining \$9.22, for Operations and Maintenance, has been added to the existing \$6.76 “sewer surcharge”, making the new sewer surcharge amount show as \$15.98 on your bill.

This is very exciting news for town staff and our customers, particularly since we are able to pay the loan off 12 years earlier than expected. If you have questions about your utility bill, please contact Town Hall. We are happy to answer any questions.
