## Rules & Guidelines:

The Texas Braunvieh Association reserves to its Show Committee the final and absolute right to interpret these rules and regulations and to arbitrarily settle and determine all matters, questions and differences in regard thereto, or otherwise arising out of or connected with or incident to the show, and the right to amend or add to these rules as its judgment may determine. An exhibitor who violates any of the following rules will forfeit all privileges and premiums. The Board of Directors of the Texas Braunvieh Association has adopted the following rules and regulations:

All exhibitors must be members of the Texas Braunvieh Association. The membership form is available online @ [www.texasbraunvieh.org](http://www.texasbraunvieh.org). Membership dues must be paid, at time of entry.

Eligibility of Cattle: (a) Animals entered must be registered in the herd book of the Braunvieh Association of America. Registration papers must be in order upon entry. (b) Animals' registration papers must be in the name of the exhibitor on or before March 25, 2019. (c) Animals must have a legible tattoo or brand corresponding to its registration papers. (d) Entries MUST include a photocopy of each animal's registration certificate. (e) Original registration papers must be presented at check-in.

Entry fees are \$40.00 per head, plus \$20.00 per Bred & Owned Heifers & Cow/Calf Pairs & \$40.00 per Bred & Owned Bull. Bred and Owned Heifers & Cow/Calf Pairs must be entered in Owned Show. All entries must be mailed to TBA, c/o Clydene Pittman, 1628 Main, Canadian, TX 79014, and postmarked by March 25, 2019. No refunds will be issued.

Bonanza entry fees of \$50 per head are due by March 25, 2019. Sponsoring breeders must pay the sponsoring fee by March 25, 2019. **Exhibitors must compete in ALL of the contests to be eligible for the Bonanza show.** Exhibitors that do not compete in each of the contests listed will not be allowed to compete in the Bonanza show. No refunds will be issued to exhibitor or breeder.

The Invitational Showmanship Contest is open to anyone who has not competed in a Braunvieh State or National show within the last two years. Contestants are competing for buckles and points towards the Incentive Program. Invitational Contestants are required to pay a \$25.00 entry fee as well as another \$25.00 to join the Texas Junior Braunvieh Association, due March 25<sup>th</sup> with late entries accepted until April 15<sup>th</sup> with a \$30 late fee.

**All exhibitors must wear the official T-Shirts when designated.**

All cattle exhibited must be properly registered and on file with Braunvieh Association of America, in the exhibitors name. Cattle exhibited must have registration papers, a legible tattoo or brand corresponding to its registration papers, and a health certificate.

Exhibitors must wear the correct show number. Numbers will be handed out in exhibitor packets at check-in for the following contests: Owned Female Show, Bred & Owned, Showmanship, Invitational Showmanship, and Bonanza/Bonanza Showmanship entries.

ALL bedding must be purchased at the Bell County Expo Center. Absolutely **NO** outside beddings will be allowed. This will cause added costs to the facility usage and that charge split amongst exhibitors that violate this rule. Bedding must be paid for prior to the end of the day Saturday.

This is a blow and go show. No fitting, adhesives, or paint will be allowed.

Females over 30 months of age as of the day of the show must show in the cow/calf class with a calf at side, and will not be eligible for Grand Overall Heifer. Calves exhibited in the cow/calf class cannot be over 230 days of age.

All other BAA show rules and guidelines apply. Please refer to [www.braunvieh.org](http://www.braunvieh.org).

All grievances must be presented in written form to the show committee within 24 hours.

Awards will be presented at the banquet at the conclusion of the show.

Everyone is expected to participate in clean-up of trash and debris. All beddings and such will be cleaned by the Bell County Expo Center staff upon your release.

Exhibitors and their entries will be released at the conclusion of the awards banquet.

If an animal being exhibited gets away from the exhibitor more than once, said animal will be subject to disqualification and will be asked to leave the show ring.

**Additional Owned Heifer Show Rules:**

Owned heifers will be divided into the following divisions

- Fullblood
- Purebred
- Beefbuilder
- Beefbuilder – Mini

Fullblood and Purebreds will show together, with the highest placing Fullblood of each class coming back for a Fullblood Division Drive. (Same for Beefbuilders & minis)

Junior members must be the owner of the animal as registered with the BAA.

Classes will not exceed five (5) head per class if possible.

Cow/calf pairs over 30 months are not eligible for Grand Champion Female (per BAA).

Beefbuilder (Percentage) females must be a minimum of 1/8 Braunvieh and registered as such with the BAA.

**Additional Bred and Owned Show Rules:**

Bred & Owned heifers and bulls will be divided into:

- Fullblood/Purebred
- Beefbuilder

Junior members must be the owner and breeder of the animal as registered with the BAA. The exhibitor must have owned the dam at the time of the calf's conception and have been the continuous owner of the animal.

Dams must be registered in the BAA Herdbook.

Beefbuilder (Percentage) females and bulls must be a minimum of 1/8 Braunvieh and registered as such with the BAA.

Embryo calves do not qualify unless the exhibitor owns the donor cow.

All Bred and Owned heifers must also be entered and shown in the Owned division of the heifer show.

Classes will not exceed five (5) head per class if feasible.

Cow/calf pairs over 30 months are not eligible for Grand Champion Female (per BAA).

It is recommended that bulls under the age of one (1) year of age be shown with a nose ring. Bulls one (1) year of age and older are REQUIRED to have a fixed nose ring.

Bulls 14 months or older are required to have a certificate verifying positive semen evaluation.

## **Showmanship:**

There will be buckles awarded to each division of each show.

Animals shall be clean and blown, no fitting for this show.

Judges may switch cattle, ask questions, or determine other methods in order to select the winners.

Awards will be presented at the banquet at the conclusion of the show.

## **Additional Showmanship Rules:**

### **Invitational Showmanship**

The Invitational Showmanship Contest is open to anyone who has not competed in a Braunvieh State or National show within the last two years.

Contestants are allowed to work with an exhibitor at the show to select a showmanship heifer.

### **Braunvieh Showmanship**

Open to any exhibitor in the Braunvieh Show (Owned Female, Bred & Owned Female or Bull).

Exhibitor must use an animal entered in one of the above shows.

### **Bonanza Showmanship**

Open to any exhibitor in the Bonanza Show.

Exhibitor must use an animal entered in the Bonanza Show.

\*Bonanza placings do not count toward high-point standings.

### **Quiz Bowl: (possibly due to time)**

Teams will be designated at random.

The contest will be single elimination competition. Correct answers are worth 10 points. There will be no penalty for incorrect answers.

There may be discussion among team members during team questions only.

Each team will have 10 seconds to buzz in. Once a team member has buzzed in, he/she will have 10 seconds to start answering the question.

### **Salesmanship:**

Competition will be on an individual basis, but participants may ask another member to assist with animal and/or props.

Cattle may not be fitted beyond clipped, washed, and blown dry.

Each competitor will bring an animal to the competition to promote and “sell” to the judges. Presentation time must be at least two (2) minutes but less than five (5) minutes. Questions do not count as presentation time.

Sales tools may be used but must be supplied by the junior exhibitor.

Presentation will be scored as follows:

- Knowledge of the animal	max 100 points
- Presentation	max 100 points
- Poise and Delivery	max 100 points
- Overall Effectiveness	max 100 points
Total	(max of 400 points)

Invitational Salesmanship contestants may apply the same concept or they can sell the Braunvieh breed as a whole or in part. For example “sell operation X on why they should purchase or implement Braunvieh genetics in their operation.”

Awards will be presented at the banquet at the conclusion of the show.

### **Illustrated Speech:**

The purpose of the Illustrated Speech Contest is to encourage public speaking and leadership abilities in youth, to develop character and leadership in youth and promote interest in the beef industry and project Braunvieh in a positive image.

The speech topic should be related to the beef industry.

Length 4 to 6 minutes for senior divisions; 3 to 5 minutes for junior and intermediate divisions.

Each contestant shall provide title and primary objective of his/her speech.

The speech must be presented orally. The theme for this year is Braunvieh in the spotlight, and should be incorporated into the speech.

A minimum of one illustration or visual aid must be prepared and used. Types of illustrations contestants are encouraged to use are charts, diagrams, props, inanimate models, puppets, posters, etc. The use of electronic devices will not be accepted, which means no slides, videos or electronic presentations are allowed.

An additional two to three minutes will be allowed following the oral presentation to answer questions, which may be asked by the judges.

Sign up at the State Show entry check-in.

### **Creative Writing:**

Creative Writing entries are due April 15, 2019 and should be emailed to [texasbraunvieh@hotmail.com](mailto:texasbraunvieh@hotmail.com). Awards will be announced at the awards banquet. Please label the creative writing file as (age division.last name.first name). Example:  
junior.williams.katy

This year's subject is: Write an essay about why your best friend should start showing Braunvieh cattle instead of whatever breed they are showing now.

Entries should be informative and entertaining. They should not be research papers.

Braunvieh cattle should be included in the story in some way.

Junior division entries may be typed or handwritten in ink. Intermediate and Senior division must be typed.

Junior entries must be between 300 and 500 words, Intermediate's must be between 600 and 800 words, and Senior's must be between 800 and 1,000 words.

All typed entries should be double spaced with a font size of 12.

Pages should be numbered.

Entries must include a cover page with the following information: contestant's name, address, phone number, birth date, and word count.

Contestant name should only be on the cover sheet. No name should be on any other page.

Entries will be evaluated with a 50 point score sheet, with each of the components receiving 1-10 points (1 being lowest and 10 being highest): content, organization, style, length and guidelines, and overall effectiveness. Proper grammar and spelling will be evaluated during the scoring of the paper. In the event of a tie, awards will go to co-winners.

Awards will be presented at the banquet at the conclusion of the show.

### **Cattleman's Quiz:**

A short multiple choice quiz that will test the knowledge of the beef industry and production as well as the history and characteristics of the Braunvieh breed. This will be a quiz to see how many correct answers each exhibitors can obtain. There is no penalty for incorrect answers.

Awards will be presented at the banquet at the conclusion of the show.

### **Skill-a-thon:**

Identification of industry tools, and what they are used for. Contestants will go from station to station to identify industry tool and/or products. Contestants will be graded on correct answers with no penalty for incorrect answers.

Awards will be presented at the banquet at the conclusion of the show.



## **Photography:**

Photography entries are due April 15, 2019 and should be emailed to [texasbraunvieh@hotmail.com](mailto:texasbraunvieh@hotmail.com). Awards will be announced at the awards banquet. Please label the photography file as (age division.last name.first name.# of photo). Example: junior.williams.katy.1 or junior.williams.katy.2

Entries should consist of photographs of Braunvieh cattle, or Braunvieh related activities.

All entries should be saved as a jpeg file, high resolution. Entries may be used in future Braunvieh promotion.

Photos must be original and not altered or enhanced in any way.

No more than two (2) photographs per exhibitor.

Photographs must have been taken by the exhibitor.

Entries that have been submitted from previous years will not be permitted.

Participant grants Texas Braunvieh Association the use and rights associated to the use of the photographic likeness, in promotional publications, and other media, without compensation.

Awards will be presented at the banquet at the conclusion of the show.

## **Sponsorship Drive:**

Contestants will accumulate points based on obtaining sponsors for the show. Each contestant will be issued a sponsorship letter of different levels as well as a sponsorship/contributor form. Contestants should notify committee members (Clydene Pittman and/or Donnie Johnson) with each and every sponsor received (this is extremely important to people that want to sponsor buckles or meals as these tend to go very fast). Also added into the Sponsorship Drive will be the sales of our Polaris Ranger raffle tickets. Points will be given as following:

\$0-99 NO Points

\$100-\$249 10 Points

\$250-\$499 15 Points

\$500+ 25 Points

### **High-Point Calculations:**

All contestants are automatically entered. Contestants must participate in ALL events to qualify.

Points will be earned in the following contests: Showmanship or Invitational Showmanship, Salesmanship, Cattleman's Quiz, Skill-a-thon, Creative Writing, Illustrated Speech, Photography, The Sponsorship Drive, and the cattle show (current Braunvieh exhibitors points will only be accumulated on your highest placing animal).

Exhibitors will accumulate points in every event that they actively participate in.

There will be a High-point junior, intermediate, and senior age contestant.

Points will be tabulated as follows:

1st place	50 points
2nd place	45 points
3rd place	40 points
4th place	35 points
5th place	30 points
Participation	25 points

Awards will be presented at the banquet at the conclusion of the show.

### **Snack Bar:**

A snack bar will be open during the entire show. Each exhibitor is asked to bring a snack (box of bagged goldfish, pan of brownies, fruit) or a drink (12 pack of soda, case of water) for the snack bar. Meals for the listed times on the schedule will also be available at no cost during show. Be sure to complete the headcount portion of the entry so that enough food will be available for meals.

## **Junior Braunvieh Association Incentive Program**

What is the Junior Braunvieh Association Incentive Program?

The Junior Braunvieh Association Incentive Program is an effort to get more junior exhibitors interested in Braunvieh cattle. Being a small group of Braunvieh enthusiasts ourselves, we feel that once people are educated on the benefits of Braunvieh genetics, whether it be in a cow/calf operation, seedstock operation, or in a feed lot operation, they will see the benefit of Braunvieh genetics. The Braunvieh breed is more than likely the biggest secret within the cattle industry. Once people see what they can do, the cattle usually tend to sell themselves to the astute cattlemen. Although we want to make everyone aware of the benefits this breed has to offer, we target the junior age sector of the industry with this program as we feel these will be the future leaders of our industry.

We will have two or three events each calendar year in which we put on competitions for the Texas Braunvieh Association junior members (juniors can be from outside of the state of Texas, they just have to become members of the TBA) to compete for certificates that will in turn be used to help purchase Braunvieh genetics from the sponsoring breeder. For example:

At our Texas Junior Braunvieh State Showcase in Belton Texas on April 25-28, 2019, junior exhibitors will compete in written, speaking, exhibiting, and identification events to earn points that will be accumulated during that weekend only. These youngsters will be attempting to accumulate the most points possible so that they can earn the title of "High Point Individual". All exhibitors will be divided into one of two groups. They will compete in either "Braunvieh Veterans" or the "Braunvieh Invitational". Then each of those two groups will be divided by age groups....Junior, Intermediate, and Senior. This will allow us to have six (6) different "High Point Individuals". The Braunvieh Veterans will receive a \$1,000 scholarship, and the Invitational exhibitors will receive a certificate in the value of \$1,000 to be used towards the purchase of a Braunvieh heifer from the breeder that sponsors the individual. This is in no way a "free" heifer. The junior exhibitor and the breeder will then need to work out the sale price of whichever heifer the two parties agree on.

The breeder will then deduct the \$1,000 certificate value from the sale price and the balance would be the responsibility of the junior exhibitor's family. Any other agreements, or dealings are between the breeder and the certificate holder. The sponsoring breeder would also be responsible for the "nomination fee" of \$500.00 in order for the heifer to be eligible for the Bonanza.

Once all the requirements are met, (see Junior Braunvieh Association Incentive Program Standards of Excellence) the sponsoring breeder agrees to pay a nomination fee to nominate the heifer he/she bred into the Bonanza that will be held during the Texas Junior Braunvieh State Show the following year. These funds will be monies that will be paid back to the junior exhibitors as scholarships or showmanship premiums. This will be a show in addition to the regular Texas Junior Braunvieh Association State Show. In this show the certificate winner will be competing against other certificate winners, along with other Bonanza participants. They will compete in all events and again try to obtain the status of "High Point Individual".

## Junior Braunvieh Association Incentive Program

### Heifer Certificate Eligibility

Heifer certificates in the amount of \$1,000 will be awarded to Hi-Point Incentive Individuals during the Texas Junior Braunvieh Showcase. Certificates will be redeemable at the sponsoring breeder. (see High-Point rules and calculations)

In the event of a tie, scores from the following event will be used in the order listed as tie breakers: Cattleman's quiz, Salesmanship, and Skill-a-thon.

To be eligible for a Heifer Certificate an exhibitor **must participate in ALL events**.

All contests are automatically entered.

It is the responsibility of the Invitational contestants to acquaint themselves with the Braunvieh exhibitors and select an animal to exhibit in showmanship. **(Invitational exhibitors must use one of the animals entered in the state show)**

Heifer Certificate recipients and their guardians must sign and agree to meet the Expected Standards of Excellence as set by the Junior Braunvieh Association Incentive Program committee before redeeming their certificate with the sponsoring breeder .

The recipient shall redeem their certificate with the sponsoring breeder for the purchase of a Braunvieh heifer. Any difference between the certificate value and the final price of the chosen heifer will be worked out between the sponsoring breeder and the certificate holder.

Any additional agreements made between the breeder and certificate holder are between those two parties. The Junior Braunvieh Association Incentive Program committee, nor the Texas Braunvieh Association will be responsible for any other agreements.

All exhibitors are expected to exhibit good sportsmanship and exemplify the **TEAM (Together Everyone Achieves More)** motto.

Heifers won under the Junior Braunvieh Association Incentive Program will be eligible to be nominated by the breeder to compete in the 2020 Bonanza at the Texas Junior Braunvieh State Showcase provided the Expected Standards of Excellence are met by both the heifer and the exhibitor.

## Junior Braunvieh Association Incentive Program

### Expected Standards of Excellence

Prior to entry, all participants must become current Texas Braunvieh Association Junior members.

- Any participant that enters the program (is awarded a certificate for heifer purchase) must maintain their membership with the Texas Braunvieh Association for duration of the program.
- The Junior Braunvieh Association Incentive Program is open to **ALL** junior age individuals that own, exhibit, or have the desire to own, or exhibit Braunvieh cattle.
- For this program a participant must be under the age of 21 as of January 1, 2018. (This would ensure an exhibitor would not have reached his/her 22nd birthday prior to January 1, 2019 and therefore still be considered a junior exhibitor to the Texas Braunvieh Association).
- Upon being awarded a certificate for purchase of a Braunvieh heifer, the recipient and his/her parents and/or legal guardians will have 45 days to review the program and make their final decision whether to enter the program or not. If either feel that they cannot fulfill the obligations of the program, they must inform the committee in writing of their intent to forego the certificate within the 45 days allotted.
- In the event that a certificate recipient chooses not to enter the program, for whatever reason, said certificate will be put back into the Junior Braunvieh Association Incentive Program. It will be at the committee's discretion as to how the certificate be awarded to the next qualified applicant.
- It will be the responsibility of the recipient and the breeder to agree to terms of the purchase of the certificate heifer.
- In the event that a recipient and a breeder cannot come to an agreement on the terms of purchase of a heifer within 14 days of initial contact about the heifer, the committee will attempt to act as a mediator in order to try to come to a resolution. In the event this cannot be accomplished, said certificate will again go back into the Junior Braunvieh Association Incentive Program. It will again be at the discretion of the committee as to how the certificate be awarded to the next qualified applicant
- ALL recipients (Texas and/or residents from out of state) will be expected to actively participate in any fundraising whether it be for the Texas Junior Braunvieh State Show or for the Junior Braunvieh Association Incentive Program.
- **ALL** recipients (Texas and/or residents from out of state) and the heifers that are purchased with the certificates are required to return to the Texas Junior Braunvieh State Showcase in 2020. The dates and location are TBD.

- Any Texas recipient who meets the age requirements for TJLA (Texas Junior Livestock Association) are required to complete both of the following:
  - a. Are required to join TJLA and exhibit a heifer in **at least two TJLA sanctioned shows**. (this can be accomplished in one day at our state show)
  - b. Are required to enter and exhibit a heifer in at least one of the Texas major stock shows that recognizes the Braunvieh breed (this will mean showing in the open division)
- Texas Senior division age recipients who have aged out of TJLA must enter and exhibit in a minimum of **two nationally recognized shows**, with at least one being at a Texas major.
- Any non-Texas recipient will be required to enter and exhibit in **a minimum of two nationally recognized shows** with at least one being at a Texas major.
- **ALL** recipients are required to join and maintain both their **Texas Braunvieh Association Junior membership** as well as their **Braunvieh Association of America Junior membership**.
- Recipient must be financially capable of providing any additional funds required for purchase, feed, care and suitable facilities.
- It is the recipient responsibility to keep in touch with the breeder as well as the Junior Braunvieh Association Incentive Program committee monthly. Email address will be provided to recipients.
- The Junior Braunvieh Association Incentive Program committee, the sponsoring breeder, the TBA or any deemed representative of the TBA may at any time be granted permission to pay a visit to your location and verify the care as well as offer any assistance for your heifer.
- Recipients and their parents and/or legal guardians must be willing and able to commit adequate time to fulfill above obligations to the heifer, breeder and TBA
- Failure to fulfill **ALL** obligations will result in registration papers being revoked and heifers will be returned to the sponsoring breeder.
- The sponsoring breeder **MUST** be granted the first right of refusal if the junior member wishes to sell the heifer after completing the requirements as stated above. The junior member must also contact the committee with such request prior to advertisement that the heifer is for sale.
- It is the responsibility of the recipient and parent/legal guardian to communicate in writing, for review by the committee, of any unforeseen hardships or events that prevent the recipient from fulfilling their required obligations as set forth in these documents
- If ALL obligations are met, to include exhibition at the Bonanza show, and the junior exhibitor retains possession of the certificate heifer, the junior exhibitor will have the option to nominate his/her heifer for the second year (senior age heifers) for the following year's Bonanza at a discounted rate. This will have to be the junior exhibitor that was awarded the certificate as well as the original heifer that was

purchased with the certificate. This is non-transferrable in any way. The original nomination fee has been covered by the sponsoring breeder, but the subsequent year will be the obligation of the junior exhibitor

1. Any exhibitor wanting to exhibit in the Braunvieh Bonanza must be in good standings with the Texas Braunvieh Association as well as the Braunvieh Association of America at the time of entry and continue to be in good standing at event date in order to participate.
2. NO animal will be allowed to be exhibited if the sponsoring breeder is not paid in full prior to March 25, 2019. ALL nomination payments must come from the sponsoring breeder. Please check with your sponsoring breeder and/or the TBA prior to entry as entry fees are non-refundable. (Note: in the case of bred and owned cattle the junior exhibitor may be the sponsoring breeder.)
3. Heifers may be exhibited as such until they reach the day of 30 months of age
4. Any heifer 20 months of age or older MUST be accompanied by a certificate of pregnancy by a licensed veterinarian.
5. There will be no cow/calf division. Females that are under 30 months of age and have a calf at side will be exhibited as a cow/calf pair in their respective class.
6. There will be no set class breaks. Classes will be made once all entries are received. Classes will be divided as deemed appropriate by the committee.
7. All other BAA show guidelines must be adhered to.
8. Each animal entered in the Braunvieh Bonanza shall be subject to DNA testing as deemed necessary at the discretion of the show committee.
9. ALL Grand and Reserve Champions will be DNA tested and confirmed prior to receiving awards
10. Heifers must also be entered in the Texas Junior Braunvieh State Show in order to be eligible to compete in the Braunvieh Bonanza
11. Please send a copy of current BAA registration papers with this entry form.
12. Heifers must be purchased directly from a Braunvieh Bonanza Sponsor or in the case of bred and owned cattle the junior exhibitor may be the sponsoring breeder.

13. Heifers cannot be transferred from one family member to another (or anyone else) and still qualify to show. This will result in disqualification. Heifer must be a direct transfer from sponsoring breeder to the junior entering the heifer in the Braunvieh Bonanza.
14. Fullblood Braunvieh must be 100% Braunvieh genetics and registered as such with the BAA.
15. Purebred Braunvieh must be a minimum 7/8 Braunvieh and show purebred status by the BAA.
16. Percentage Braunvieh (Beefbuilder) must be a minimum of 1/8 Braunvieh but less than 7/8 Braunvieh and be registered as such by the BAA.
17. Each exhibitor is allowed to enter as many heifers as they wish. Each entry will need its own entry card and applicable entry fee. Each entry must be purchased from a sponsoring breeder.
18. Showmanship will be broken down into 6 different age groups. Age groups will be determined by the age of exhibitor **as of the date of show**.
19. Age groups will be as follows:
  - a. 7-9 years old
  - b. 10-12 years old
  - c. 13-15 years old
  - d. 16-18 years old
  - e. 19 years old and over
20. In order to be eligible for ANY prize money from the Braunvieh Bonanza each **exhibitor must compete in ALL of the contests, and sponsorship**. Exhibitors that do not these requirements will not be allowed to compete in the Bonanza show. No refunds will be issued to exhibitor or breeder.
21. Any Texas recipient who meets the age requirements for TJLA (Texas Junior Livestock Association) are required to complete both of the following:
  - a. Are required to join TJLA and exhibit a heifer in **at least two TJLA sanctioned shows**. (this can be accomplished in one day at our state show)
  - b. Are required to enter and exhibit a heifer in at least one of the Texas major stock shows that recognizes the Braunvieh breed (this will mean showing in the open division)
22. Texas Senior division age recipients who have aged out of TJLA must enter and exhibit in a minimum of **two nationally recognized shows**, with at least one being at a Texas major.
23. Any non-Texas recipient will be required to enter and exhibit in **a minimum of two nationally recognized shows** with at least one being at a Texas major.
24. To be eligible for ANY Bonanza prizes (from show or showmanship) the exhibitor must exhibit his or her own animal.
25. All premiums and prizes will be held until ALL requirements have been met.
