DESCRIPTION: Beautiful high-end short hunting bow. African rosewood and phenolic riser. Great looking and performing recurve. As with many short bows, the Indian specs recommended a draw length no longer than 28". It can be fairly easily drawn to 28", but begins to stack at 26.5". Accordingly, this bow is best suited to someone with a shorter draw length. Nice looking overlays on both the face and back of the riser. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes (see exception below); No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decal is in excellent condition. This is a really nice bow in exceptional condition for its age. There is one drilled hole behind the side plate that may have been for a screw-in arrow rest (see pic on p. 5). Has string silencers on the face of the limbs (see pic last page). Comes with the string shown.

This bow sold new for \$105 in 1971 which translates to \$682 in 2021 inflation adjusted dollars.
