General Information

Garbage & Recycle Collection

The Town provides garbage collection service and recycle collection service for all Town Residents, contracting services from Freedom Junk Removal Inc. Garbage carts are picked up every week on Monday's and Recycle carts are emptied every other week, also on Monday's. Each property owner received one (1) trash cart and one (1) recycle cart per household. New residents should contact the Sedalia Town Hall to be added to the collection route and receive their carts. This service is provided at no additional cost to the owner. If additional carts are needed, this can be provided at cost to the current resident, and this can be arranged as well with Town Hall staff.

Please have all carts at the roadside curb by 6:30 am by Monday mornings, Please also remember to pull emptied carts back to your house or at least away from the curb. Garbage collections is for normal household garbage and recyclables only. Recycle carts with food or other contaminated items will not be collected. If you have specific requests or needs, such as bulk item pickup, please reach out to Freedom to arrange these at cost services. The Town has one master account with Freedom, please reach out to the Sedalia Town Hall with your regular garbage collection questions, or if you need a recycling collection schedule

Animal Control

Animal Control Protection Services – The Town provides this service for all Town Residents through the Guilford County Department of Animal Control. Please keep in mind that Guilford County has a Leash Law in place where all dogs must be on a leash when off of your property. All animals must be controlled and/or contained on

the owners property so as to not be allowed to run at large. Also remember that unattended tethering (chaining of dogs) in Guilford County is prohibited. If you have a problem with loose, stray, injured or vicious animals, please call GC Animal Control at (336) 641-5990 or the GC Sheriff's Department.

Town Hall Grounds Use

The Town Hall grounds are made available for special events such as yard sales and small birthday parties. A completed request form along with a \$50 deposit is required at least five (5) days prior to the event. This form must be signed by a Town Official/Town Clerk. Official meetings of the Town government and its boards have priority over other activities. The deposit will be returned after the event is over, if no damage was done to the property, and no trash was left on the grounds. Inside use of the building is not allowed.

New Town Residents

If you are new to the Sedalia area, please contact the Sedalia Town Hall Office so our records can be updated and so individuals can receive information such as the Town Meeting Schedule and to be added to the collection route for the garbage & recycle service.

Town Meetings

Town Council Meetings are generally held on the 1st Monday of each month. Planning Board meetings are held on the 3rd Thursday of each month and Agenda meetings are held on the 4th Monday of each month. Exceptions are made if the date falls on or close to a holiday. All meetings are open to the public and Meeting Schedules are available at the Sedalia Town Hall. Participants can now attend meetings remotely via Zoom. Please contact the Town Hall prior to the meeting date to be added to the email list to receive meeting invitations.

Mail

If you are a Sedalia resident, meaning your home is located within the Sedalia jurisdiction, and you have a mailbox in front of your home or plan to put one up, you will need to be added to the Gibsonville mail route at the Gibsonville Post Office, 221 E. Main St. You will have a Gibsonville mailing address with a zip code of 27249. If you prefer a Sedalia Post Office Box, you may purchase one at the Sedalia Post Office, 6151 Burlington Road. You can collect mail there, and you will have a Sedalia, NC mailing address with a zip code of 27342.

If you are not receiving the monthly automated calls from the town, please contact the Sedalia Town Hall and submit your phone number (home or cell) to be added to the CallingPost list. We use this service to keep our residents updated on meetings and upcoming events. Feel free to provide your email address for town updates as well.

Code Enforcement
