Regular Season Recap for BP Sports

With only 14 games remaining in the football season (13 NFL playoff games plus the National Championship), we thought it would be a good time to recap the season here at BP Sports. First, we wouldn't be here without your support and patronage during a very difficult 2020 for all of us. Again, we can't thank you enough that you took kept with us this year and for that we'll be forever grateful to you.

This season was historic on two fronts. First, we had our best season ever in CFB as we went 39-22-1 (64%) including the bowl games. We were much more selective in our bets this season due to all the uncertainty surrounding COVID but it worked with great success in college. However, we will be back to more volume and higher-rated plays in 2021. On the negative side, we had by far our worst NFL season ever on these pages with an atrocious 19-32-1 best bet record in the regular season. Prior to this season we've never had a losing season in the NFL on these pages and we've never been below 56% in any season in the NFL! We didn't do anything drastically different than past seasons, but rest assured we will be making some changes in our NFL handicapping process in 2021 as this season was unacceptable.

Because of COVID we do think it was a much more challenging season and the other newsletters were a combined 280-361-9 (44%) so our performance wasn't so bad in comparison.

It does give us great pleasure that when you factor in the combined record in the last 6 years, we are the No. 1 most accurate newsletter (see page 2) in the regular season by far. It's not even close as we have a 50-game lead on the Sports Reporter in terms of overall net wins in CFB/NFL.

As with any season win or lose, there are still many lessons to be taken from this year. First and foremost, there are no guarantees in this industry and winning consistently is very hard to do. Keep in mind, the Nevada sports books have only had one losing month in 7 years and that was this July when there weren't many sports taking place. That's some pretty stiff competition we're going up against every single week, month and year. Obviously, the market continues to evolve especially with the nation wide legalization bringing more money and competition into the market place.

Since 2012, Ohio State is 9-1 straight up (+15.8 ppg) and 9-1 ATS (+19.8 ppg) as an underdog. The only loss was vs Clemson last year.

† Alabama 40 Ohio State 34. These two haven't met since Ohio St upset Alabama in the first year of the CFB Playoff back in 2014. It is notable that Alabama has failed to cover their last 4 National Championship games after Saban (with more time to prep) easily covered the 3 BCS Championship game appearances. The Buckeyes come in at 7-0 SU/4-3 ATS. After an underwhelming stretch in Big Ten play that included closer than expected wins over Indiana and Northwestern, the Buckeyes played by far their best game of the season by beating Clemson 49-28 with a 639-444 yards edge. Clearly OSU used last year's blown lead to the Tigers and Dabo Swinney's comments as extra motivation. QB Justin Fields despite taking a big hit early, threw for 385 yards and 6 TD's. Meanwhile, the Crimson Tide have played nearly a full schedule at 12-0 SU/8-4 ATS. Alabama, took their foot off the gas vs Notre Dame in a 31-14 win (Tide had a 7.9-4.7 yards per play advantage) and out-gained ND despite running 25 less plays. Alabama is led by the Heisman Trophy Winner DeVonta Smith and his 20 receiving TD's but also have RB Najee Harris (24 TD's) and QB Mac Jones (77%, 36-4 ratio). They also could get back WR Jaylen Waddle. Still, OSU is the best underdog team in the country (see ATS stat to left) and we think the Buckeyes are peaking at the right time. This one is only a lean because we don't know how healthy Fields is and there are COVID issues coming out of Columbus on Tuesday night.

AFC/NFC Wild Card Forecasts

Games in Rotation Order

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

Saturday, January 9th

AFC Wildcard: Indianapolis at Buffalo. 1:05pm ET on CBS.

Lean Indianapolis (+6.5), it's a 1★ at +7. BUFFALO 27 Indianapolis 23. No team is playing better than the Buffalo Bills right now who have remarkably covered in 8 straight games. They get their first home playoff game since 1996 and it is the first time fans have been allowed to see them play at home this year (6,700 tickets sold-out). Last week they scored their most points since 1966 in a blowout win over Miami. QB Josh Allen set franchise-record for passing yards (4,544) and total TD's (45) in a season. They're taking on an Indianapolis that benefited from playing one of the weakest schedules in the NFL this season. The Colts were favored in 15 of their 16 games and this is by far their biggest underdog role of the season (were +1 at Cleveland). Their head coach Frank Reich should have found memories of playoff games in Buffalo after orchestrating the biggest comeback in NFL history 28 years ago as a QB for the Bills. The Colts do have the better defense here and we think you're paying a point-spread premium now on the Bills because of their long cover streak. We lean Indy.

NFC Wildcard: L.A. Rams at Seattle. 4:40pm ET on FOX.

Lean UNDER 42.5, it's a 1★ at UNDER 43. SEATTLE 20 L.A. Rams 17. The big question here is who will start at QB for the Rams. Obviously, these two division rivals are very familiar with one another and Seattle just beat LA 20-9 here two weeks ago. The Seahawks have notably been outgained at home this year while the Rams are +149 ypg on the road. The Rams do have the better defense and have played the tougher schedule so we would lean with them here as long as you're getting +3.5 or more. However, we prefer the UNDER. Totals players note that Seattle games had gone UNDER in 7 straight games prior to last week vs the 49ers where THIRTY-FOUR 4Q points handed UNDER backers a bad beat and a close loss. Meanwhile, Rams games are 12-4 to the UNDER this year. Both meetings between these two failed to top 40 points this year and now you either have a banged up Jared Goff or John Wolford at QB for the Rams.

NFC Wildcard: Tampa Bay at Washington. 8:15pm ET on NBC.

1★ WASHINGTON (+8). Tampa Bay 24 WASHINGTON 20. You may laugh at Washington being in the playoffs with a 7-9 record but be very wary of a disrespected team. Since the NFL went to the current division format in 2002, there have been 7 teams that have made the playoffs with a 8-8 or worse record. How did those teams do? How about a perfect 7-0 ATS (+11 ppg) and remarkably 6-1 straight up (+6.6 ppg). The market wants to fade the so-called bad team and you're actually getting good value betting them. Also keep in mind, Washington is 5-1 with Alex Smith as the starting QB this year. You can throw out a lot of those games when they had a terrible Dwayne Haskins behind center. Speaking of behind center, obviously Tom Brady made a heck of a difference for the Bucs this year as they notched their first 11-win season since 2005. He has plenty of weapons including WR Mike Evans (check his status) and a stout defense. They did struggle against the better teams on their schedule going 1-4 SU and -70 ypg vs winning teams (we know Washington isn't one so keep that in your back pocket for next week). However, do you want to lay more than a TD on the road in the playoffs against a Washington defense that has held 7 straight opponents to 20 points or less? We lean UNDER but prefer taking 8-points with the Football team here.

Sunday, January 10th

AFC Wildcard: Baltimore at Tennessee. 1:05pm ET on ABC/ESPN.

Lean Tennessee (+3), it's a 1★ at +3.5. Baltimore 28 TENNESSEE 27. Tennessee has had Baltimore's number the last couple of years pulling the shocker last year in the playoffs as big underdogs (BAL did have a 530-300 yard edge) and also upset the Ravens earlier this year as 6-point road underdogs. Despite their 11-5 record, Tennessee was out-gained on the season (-2 ypg) as they were 7-2 in games decided by 7 points or less. After a 5-0 start, they were just 6-5 their last 11. The OVER has gone 12-3-1 in their games including cashing 7 of their last 8. Meanwhile, Baltimore is playing their best ball of the season including 6 straight covers and 5 straight wins. It should be noted the only winning team they beat down the stretch was a road win at Cleveland that could have gone either way. Both teams have had great success running as Baltimore led the NFL averaging 192 ypg while Tennessee's Derrick Henry ran for more than 2,000 yards. Tough to ignore the last two game's results and now Tennessee is getting a FG at home. We lean with the Titans.

NFC Wildcard: Chicago at New Orleans. 4:40pm ET on CBS.

Lean OVER 47. NEW ORLEANS 29 Chicago 20. Again, be careful of automatically throwing Chicago in the dumpster for this game. 8-8 or worse teams are on a 7-0 ATS and 6-1 SU run in the wild card. However, not many of those 8-8 teams are playing a team the caliber of New Orleans in the wild card round. The Saints would have been on a bye in any other playoff season as they are the No. 2 seed. From a pure power ratings aspect, the Saints are No. 1 in the NFL overall in both Sagarin and DVOA, two of the more respected ratings metrics. The Saints won 9 straight games in the middle of the season but an early season loss at home to Green Bay prevented them from getting home field advantage. Somehow, the Bears survived a 6-game losing streak in the middle of the season to get here. Still, they have a Top 10 defense and a Top 10 special teams unit. 10 points is a lot to lay and the Bears were competitive vs the Saints earlier this season in an OT loss at home. We prefer to back the OVER here which has cashed in 5 of Chicago's last 6 games and went 10-6 in New Orleans games this year. Also you never have to worry about weather this time of year in the dome

AFC Wildcard: Cleveland at Pittsburgh. 8:15pm ET on NBC.

1★ PITTSBURGH (-6). PITTSBURGH 28 Cleveland 19. Pittsburgh has won 17 straight home games vs Cleveland by an average of 13.5 ppg going 11-6 ATS (+5.5 ppg) in those games. They destroyed the Browns at home earlier this year 38-7. Despite playing a lot of back-ups (8 starters were out including QB Roethlisberger), the Steelers nearly upset the Browns last week as 10-point underdogs losing 24-22. Obviously, the big news here is that this is the first playoff game for the Browns in 18 years. Unfortunately for them, their head coach Kevin Stefanski will be out for this game due to COVID protocols and a couple players could also miss as well including their starting OG. The Steelers have the No. 1 defense in the NFL according to DVOA and are playing a Cleveland team that benefited from playing one of the weakest schedules in the NFL. Despite playing that weak schedule, the Browns are the only playoff team this season to be out-scored on the season! Can you say overrated? On top of that, Pittsburgh has so much more playoff experience on their roster. We like the Steelers here.
