

This meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners, District 4, Township of Franklin, Gloucester County NJ was called to order on October 28<sup>th</sup>, 2025 @ 19:00 and attended by the members noted below. This meeting was called pursuant to the provisions of the Open Public Meetings Law. This meeting was included in a list of meeting notices sent to the Courier Post newspaper, filed with the Municipal Clerk at the Township of Franklin, County of Gloucester and posted at the Forest Grove Volunteer Fire Company.

### 2. Reading of the minutes of the previous meeting

A motion to accept the previous meeting minutes as read was made by Thomas Bellone and seconded by Andrew Bellone. No changes to be made.

### 3. Treasurers Report & Bills against the Commission

Joseph Scapellato reported:

Petty cash balance \$231.20

We received the last insurance check in the amount of \$4,182.81 for the generator repairs.

A replacement check will be sent to Blaze equipment. The previous check was lost in the mail.

The fourth payment installment for the insurance was paid to Glenn Insurance. Mr. Myronowskyj will hand deliver the check.

Mr. Scapellato will be using the petty cash to purchase stamps.

A motion to pay all bills and to accept the Treasurers report was made by Mykola Myronowskyj and seconded by Thomas Bellone.



#### 4. Old Business

Mr. Myronowskyj worked with Bolster hardware and all issues have been resolved, our account is up to date.

Mr. Myronowskyj worked with WB Mason to resolve issues. Apparently we have been getting late notices for a positive balance on our account. The credit was applied to the account and the issues have been resolved.

Mykola Myronowskyj reached out to our previous insurance agent, Kelly. Her non-compete agreement will expire in December. In December we will revisit and ask her to quote a policy with VFIS. The workmans compensation insurance that we share with 2 other departments will remain as it is.

Mr. Joe Scapellato was able to perform all work needed to title and register the new 2025 Seagrave engine.

Resolution for the 2026 Commissioner compensation package was sent to the town council for presentation at the next council meeting. Unfortunately due to a clerical error, the Resolution will not be voted upon until the November meeting.

Mykola Myronowskj is working with DTA Solutions to determine if we can transfer the QuickBooks program from one computer to another without having to purchase a new version. Further details as events warrant.

The final amount due to Seagrave after applying the credits and debits is \$84,632.88. Per a conversation with Wayne from Seagrave, we will be withholding this payment until all of the "we owe" and initial warranty issues that are being discovered are corrected. Mr. Myronowskyj is keeping a email open with Seagrave with each issue as we find them, and will report as they are fixed. At this time nothing has been fixed and all warranty issues are outstanding.

#### 5. New Business

Tower ladder bucket was damaged on a call when it was backed into a telephone pole. Mr. Myronowskyj is working with the insurance company, Blaze Fire apparatus for a quote, and the insurance adjuster. Claim #NJCM25100459 has been assigned. The initial inspection revealed that the bucket cannot be used for personnel as it is a safety concern, however it can be used as an elevated waterway. The appraiser was onsite and we are waiting for his appraisal.

Nightlinger engagement letter for 2026 was presented to the Board for signature. Chairman, Treasurer and Secretary signed the document and Mr. Myronowskyj will send it to the auditor.

2026 budget review was completed. All Board members present approved the proposed budget. This will be sent to the auditor to finalize the budget package to send to the state.
