## Good morning!

Just want to give the ruling for a play that is seen a few times a year and talked about WAY more! Can a team have all 5 players out of bounds on a throw-in? Take a look at an example <a href="here">here</a>.

Since this is a spot throw-in, it is illegal. Rule 9.3.3 and case play 9.2.9 define this. *On a throw-in after a made goal or after a timeout immediately following a made goal,* having all five players OOB when the thrower-in has the ball at his/her disposal is legal.

In the play in the video, when the ball is placed at the disposal of the thrower-in, the other 4 players must immediately be in-bounds. If they are not, it is a throw-in violation.
