Gospel: Mark 6: 1-6.

"Not without Honour"

The Scriptures speak to us today about the role of the prophet,
about being chosen by God to be His instruments and witnesses,
and about putting trust in His presence and power to accomplish
that mission.

We see three such prophets (Ezekiel, Paul and Jesus) who were
rejected and scorned by their very own people for the message they
brought. Ezekiel is among his own Jewish exiles, taken off by the
Babylonians into captivity. Paul is defending himself and his
ministry against those who doubt his authenticity and he is
suffering, "hardships, persecutions and constraints, for the sake of
Christ." Jesus is with his own people, in "his native place,
accompanied by his disciples."

Some truths are hard to hear and Ezekiel, Paul, Jesus and other
prophets, most frequently meet opposition.

These prophets offer words from God's loving but urgent words
and require change in both thinking and acting.

Jesus makes it very clear that to be true disciples, we must open
our eyes to the revelation that He brings; we must look at the world
around us, and at one another, through His eyes, and live by that
prophetic vision of His Gospel. It is that which allows us to claim
that we belong to Him, and which enables us to know that we are
never outside the range of God's love. No matter where our exile,
God is there speaking to us through the prophets - both ancient and
modern-day.

There is no containing the will of God. His choice is final - and no
matter how inadequate we modern-day prophet may feel, we
always speak with the authority of Jesus the Lord, making Him
known to the people, and bringing His love and justice into their
hearts.
