## FALL BOAT CARE

As you get ready to put your boat into storage for the winter, here are some [suggested care tips from Bass Pro Boating Center](#) and [BoatPlanet](#) that will help keep your boat in good shape and ready for the spring!

**Clean and wax your hull**—The gelcoat outermost layer of a fiberglass hull protects the inner layers. Cleaning off the dirt helps prevent permanent staining. Applying a protective wax coating helps replenish the oils and bring back its luster.

**Prevent mold and mildew**—Vent your boat cover for good airflow to minimize retention of moisture as winter air can shift between humid and dry inviting mildew.

**Vacuum cushions**—Set them upright to allow airflow during storage.

**Lubricate snaps and zippers on canvas covers** (whether they are left on the boat or not).

**Oil hinges and door latches** so they will work smoothly next spring.

**Check your lines and snubbers for wear.** Note if lines are damaged so that you can get replacements now and be ready for spring. Whip ends if they are fraying.
