### A Holiday Message

# "Gates of Wisdom" Rabbi Doniel Abramowitz

eadbolts, security systems and armored carswe all go through great lengths to protect that which we cherish. Now imagine if a king would grant you a piece of his greatest treasure and carefully instructs you about how to keep it safe from all harm. He even builds a vault with strong steel doors and places the treasure inside. All you have to do is close the doors at the first sign of trouble. And now you are negligent in this duty. Even worse, you swing the gates wide open and allow the danger free access to the treasure that the king entrusted you with. The judgment for such a poor watchman is no doubt harsh.

The parsha begins with "judges and officers you shall appoint in all your gates – which Hashem your G-d give you". Although this is a literal commandment to appoint actual physical people as judges and officers in every city to enforce Torah law it can also be understood homiletically. We are all granted a soul that is "a portion of G-d above". We have various openings on our face. They have gates with which to seal them. Our mouth has teeth and lips to close it. Eves have evelids to shut out the world and ears have the skin hanging underneath to cover and fingers that come to a point to insert in the canal to stop the sounds of the world from entering. Using these, our eyes, ears and mouth is how we interface with the world. But it is also how foreign ideas and images enter our soul.

The concept here is to enact judges at each gate. For our eyes we need to make a ruling- is this something that would be beneficial to view in my service of G-d? If yes, then by all means, take in the view. If not, we have a gate to close- our eyelids to keep these things out. The same is true with what we hear- it also needs to be scrutinized. Is this lashon hara, is this scornful or debasing? Is there anything positive to come from this conversation? Again, if yes, then listen and enjoy. If not, close your ears and do not allow it in.

Lastly, is your mouth. There is a saying that, before you say something you are its master; once you say something it is a master over you. *Continued on p.2*
