Street Haven is a feminist non-for-profit organization that provides wrap-around services for highly vulnerable women in Toronto including shelter services, emergency hotel services, supportive housing, mental health and addictions support and treatment services and employment support services. We have operated one of Canada's first and oldest women's shelter services and are proud of our rich history in providing housing, social care, health and training supports to Toronto's marginalized women. Annually, we serve approximately 1500 women, and we have supported tens of thousands of women in our nearly 60-year history.

Street Haven is looking to recruit two board directors to help guide and shape the next strategic plan and to continue to support the governance of the evolution of the organization as we look to further expand the organization's impact.
